The team's Board of Directors and coaching staff have adopted this Code of Conduct to provide guidelines and expectations. As a parent/guardian, swimmer or coach, I understand that I am representing the Mazomanie Barracudas Swim Team and the Village of Mazomanie, and will demonstrate good sportsmanship.

As a **Barracuda swimmer**, I will at all times:

- Show respect, encouragement, and support of teammates and competitors.
- Not use disrespectful or offensive behaviors, words or actions.
- Listen, follow directions, and show respect towards coaches, lifeguards, officials, and meet volunteers.
- Come to swim practice or meets on time, ready to swim, and prepared with all necessary equipment.
- Be responsible for all belongings and respect others personal belongings.
- Not interfere, disrupt, or distract other swimmers.
- Learn, understand and follow proper pool safety and swim etiquette.
- Give your best positive attitude and effort at practices and meets.

If a swimmer is found in violation of the above Code of Conduct, discipline will be at the discretion of the Head Coach, Assistant Coach and/or Swim Team Board of Directors.

Discipline may include:

1st Offense: A written or verbal warning will issued and parents will be notified.

2nd Offense: Written notification to parents and removal from a minimum of one practice and/or 1 meets suspension. Swimmer may be suspended for additional practices/meets as warranted by the situation.

3rd Offense: Dismissal from the team for the rest of the season and, possibly, indefinitely if warranted. In this situation, no refunds will be issued.
