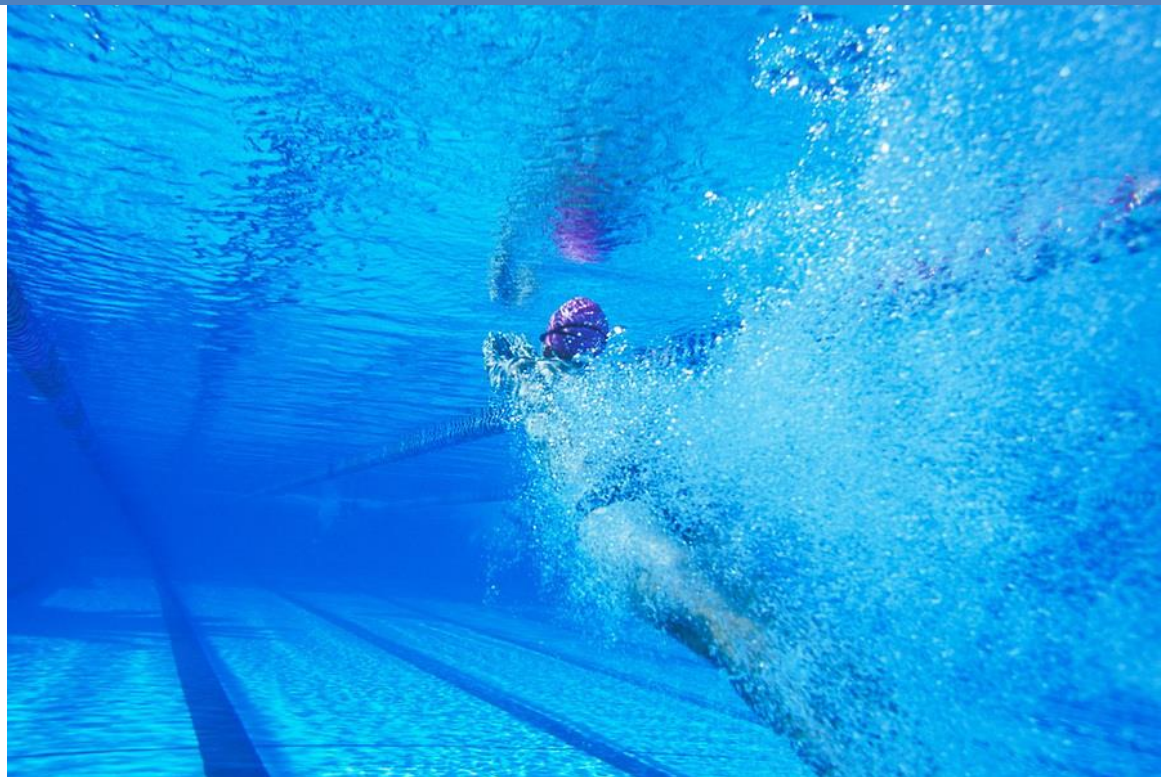

\* Progression of competition levels: Level 0 (club meets) >> Level 1 >> Level 2 >> Level 3 >> Level 4 >> Level 5 >> Level 6 (The Olympic Games)

\*\* The progression of competitive opportunities indicates a priority for representation as outlined by both CIASA and the CIOC. It is expected that athletes should endeavor to represent the Cayman Islands at the highest level of competition available in each given year.

\*\*\* Please note that for most multi-sport Games CIASA works in conjunction with the Cayman Islands Olympic Committee during the selection process. The notable exception is Island Games. In process CIASA will share athlete recommendations with the CIOC in rank order and the Olympic Committee will make final selections based on athlete slots available. Final selection will be up to the CIOC.

\*\*\*\* It should be noted that meeting a time standard set by CIASA does not insure final selection for a competition by either CIASA or the CIOC.
