## Commonwealth Games

### 2022 Selection Process

- 1) Team members must sign the 2021 - 2022 RTA agreement. Team members not in good standing may be dismissed at any time at the discretion of the RTC and/or the CIASA Technical director.
- 2) To be eligible for selection swimmers must have achieved **one or more** qualifying times within 18 months prior to the start of the Commonwealth Games. Qualifying times refer to only LCM times in any event that have achieved a minimum of 650 FINA points.
- 3) The selection criteria for the 2022 Commonwealth Games Selection:
  - A) Only swimmers that are Caymanian by right or status will be eligible
  - B) The final number of swimmers selected will be based on available funding as determined by the CIOC. Final selection will be recommended by CIASA and decided by the CIOC.
  - C) Selection will be based on the FINA Point Selection System.
  - D) The following are the FINA Point Selection System Criteria for the 2022 Commonwealth Games:
    1. Times swam within the 18 month window prior to the start of the Commonwealth Games. Only Long Course Meters times will considered for the FINA point system.
    2. The FINA point system will be based on a minimum of 650 FINA points.
    3. Each swimmer's highest scoring event will be used for selection.
  - E) Selected or pre-selected Cayman resident swimmers may be asked to attend regular "2022 Commonwealth Games Team" training/practice sessions and are expected to attend.
  - F) The 2022 Commonwealth Games is a full rest / taper competition for any swimmer selected for the team. All swimmers selected for the team are expected to comply with the expectation to taper/rest fully for the 2022 Commonwealth Games as determined by the Technical Director. No exceptions to this expectation will be granted.
