Facility: An Indoor, 6 Lane, 25 Yard Competition Pool with non--turbulent lane lines. Full size basketball gym is available for the teams' crash area. Swimmers will enter the pool through the bullpen located in the Family locker room. Swimmers will exit the pool through the Men's and Women's locker rooms. Only swim coaches who are attached to a participating team, athletes, and meet workers will be allowed on deck during the meet.

Coaches please bring your own chairs.

Spectators can view the meet from the spectator area bleachers on the South and Southwest ends of the pool. All spectators must enter and exit the pool through the steel door located between the Aquatic Directors office and Pool viewing room.

Eligibility: This will be a closed YMCA invitational and will count as one of the required meets. YMCA rules shall govern "swimming up" in the relays.

Schedule:

Warm ups at 7:00 AM – 7:50 AM

Officials Meeting at 7:30 AM. Coaches Meeting at 7:50 AM if necessary. Meet Starts at 8:00 AM

Entry Limit: All events are Timed Finals. Swimmers may enter a maximum of 4 individual events and may enter a maximum of 2 relays, not exceeding 5 total events. Any swimmer who enters more than the prescribed number of events will be scratched down to the event limit starting with the highest event number. Each team will be permitted to enter 2 scoring relays (A&B) for each relay event. Teams may enter exhibition relays. (C, D, etc) You may enter "Relay Only" swimmers in the meet to swim on relays even if they do not have individual events. Those swimmers are limited to 2 relays maximum and their names must be included with your team's entries and must pay the posted surcharge for entering the meet.

Entries: Entries will be accepted via email starting January 3 through January 11th or until the meet is filled. Any entries/updates submitted after the entry deadline will be considered deck entries and will only be accepted to fill empty lanes; no new heats will be added.

Entry Fees: \$10 per athlete non-refundable surcharge. \$5 per individual event. \$20 per relay. Send payments to:

Procedure: All entries must be sent to Alie Morgan at alie.morgan@gwrymca.org. All entries/updates must be submitted in Team Manager (HYTEK compatible) format. No paper or disk entries will be accepted. Meet information and the Team Manager event file can be found on the Riptide website at www.cmtyriptide.org. We will confirm receipt of all entries/updates by reply email. If you do not receive confirmation by January 12 of your electronic submission, please contact Alie Morgan at 618.346.5600 or alie.morgan@gwrymca.org

All fees must be paid by the start of the meet. A 5% charge will be added to all payments not received by then.

Deck Entries: Deck entry requests sent after January 12th should be submitted in a Word document and should include all required swimmer information (name, DOB, number, etc...). Riptide reserves the right to accept deck entries and will only be accepted to fill open lanes.

Heat Sheets: Heat sheets will be available to purchase for \$5 at the meet.

Warm-ups: Time and lane assignments will be sent to coaches and posted on our website

prior to the meet.

Scoring: Scoring will be top 6 places as follows:

Individual events = 7, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 (Limit 3 scores per team, keep manual scoring log) Relay events = 14, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 (Only 2 relays per team may score).

Results: Results will be posted somewhere in the YMCA and on Meet Mobile.

Awards: Individual events: Ribbons for 1st place through 6th place. Relay events: Medals for all event winners, Ribbons for 2nd place through 6th place. A team trophy will be awarded to the top team. Host team will be excluded.

Protests: Can only be presented by the coaches to the meet referee.

Officials: For planning purposes, we ask each team to send a list of YMCA certified officials to the meet referee, Jeff King at jpkking84@gmail.com.

Timers: Teams will be asked to provide timers in proportion to their entered athletes. Teams will be notified of the number of timers needed after compiling the entries. It is the team's responsibility to fill timer positions.

Lap Counters: Athletes/teams are responsible for providing lap counters for events where required.

Scratches: Accepted at all times throughout the meet. Please notify the AO before the race occurs. Athletes will not be allowed to change events.

Concessions: There will be concessions available during the meet. The concessions area is located in the pool viewing room.

Hospitality: There will be hospitality available during the meet for coaches and officials only. The hospitality area is located in the childwatch room.

Vendors: All Pro T's will be on-site selling Kings of the Pool clothing. A link to an online store was sent to each team for pre-orders.

Rules:

- ❖ The meet shall be governed by the 2022 USA Swimming Rules as dictated by "Rules that govern YMCA Swimming".
- ❖ The only swimsuits permitted are those in compliance with FINA and USA Swimming rules.
- ❖ Coaches are expected to maintain appropriate swimmer conduct. The Meet Director and/or Meet Safety Marshals/Officials will exclude any swimmer or

parent from the meet for unsafe, disruptive or bad behavior, at the meet referee's discretion.

- ❖ Swimmers and coaches must obey meet officials at all times.
- ❖ All swimmers must report to the bullpen before each event, except for the 500 for which the swimmers will report directly to the starting blocks. It is the swimmer's responsibility to report on time. Failure to do so will result in the athlete being scratched from that event.
- ❖ Only swimmers competing in the current session, coaches of entered teams, and officials and volunteers working in the current session/area will be allowed in the bullpen or the swimmers area of the pool deck.
- ❖ Spectators must be quiet during all starts.
- ❖ No flash photography during starts.
- ❖ No coolers will be allowed on the pool deck.
- ❖ No smoking anywhere in the facility or on YMCA property.
- ❖ Please keep trash picked up in team areas.
- ❖ Cell phones, cameras and video recording equipment are not permitted in locker room areas.
