




25-m Marshalling


Pool and Marshalling Area

- The pink area indicates the marshalling area.
- For Swim Fest & Splash, there are 6 adult volunteers




1. Enter Marshalling Area

- Coaches bring swimmers to entry point of the staging area.
- Coaches and Adult Volunteer put swimmer in correct event and heat staging area.




2. Move to on-deck marshalling

- As marshalling seats become available on deck, an adult volunteer will move the swimmers on deck one heat at a time.




3. Moving along

- As each heat swims, the coming heats shift one set of seats at a time as shown on the flow chart.
- There are volunteers positioned as indicated.



4. Time to Swim!


- When the current heat is in the water, the adult volunteer will walk the next heat out to the 25-m starting blocks or the main starting blocks, as appropriate.



Volunteer Details

- There is should be Lead Marshal guiding the others and ensuring that all the signs and heat indicators are ready BEFORE people start entering the marshalling area.
- 25-m volunteers need 2 sets of laminated heat signs, as the acoustics are bad.
- 25-m volunteers need laminated strips with lane numbers for the staging area.
- The relays are tough, with 4 swimmers on each team. The process needs to be adjusted for relays.
- Older swimmers using the warmup/warmdown pool need to use an alternative entrance to and from the pool deck.
