

Tulare Sharks Swim Team

Meet Requirements

MEET LOCATION

- Meets will be held at Mission Oak High School (3442 East Bardsley Avenue, Tulare, CA 93274). Warm-ups will begin at 5:30 pm. Meets begin at 6:00 pm. There is no time limit on our meet. It is the discretion of the visiting team as to the meet time limits.

POOL, LANES & EVENTS

- We will be running ten (10) lanes. Visiting teams will be assigned the odd number lanes: 1,3,5,7,9. There are starting blocks on both ends of the pool.
- We will run unlimited heats in Freestyle and Backstroke. IM, Butterfly, Breast and relays will be limited to three (3) heats. Our roster is approximately 230 swimmers.
- Visiting team will provide two (2) timers and one (1) recorder for lanes 1,3,5,7,9 respectively and two (2) stroke and turn judges throughout the meet. Please have timers, recorders and judges in place no later than 5:45 pm. We do not take any breaks during the meet.

CAMPING

- Visiting team area will be on the North side of the pool on the grass. There is not a lot of shade; you are advised to provide your own shades. Please let everyone know to stay off the areas marked with caution tape. Swimmers are not allowed on the south side of the pool in the computer and coaches area.

COACH INFORMATION

- Using Hy-Tek Team Manager, please email your team's roster to tularesharks@gmail.com at least two (2) days prior to the start of the meet. This will be a seeded meet. This allows time to load the team roster without delaying the meet due to technical difficulties. If this information cannot be provided at least two (2) days prior to the meet, your swimmers may not receive awards that evening.
- A paper copy of the results will be provided for the visiting team. We will also email results to the visiting team and CVRSL.
- All CVRSL rules will be recognized. Stroke and turn rules will be used for all ages and all events.
- We will not be keeping score. This will in no way affect the awarding of ribbons to swimmers. We will make every effort to have ribbons completed before the end of the meet. In the event we are unable to complete them, please provide a contact person so we may get them delivered to you.
- A well-stocked concession stand will be available. There are usually other food vendors as well, such as taco trucks and Kona Ice. No glass containers, alcoholic beverages, or smoking will be allowed on the high school campus. Please clean up all trash in your team area before leaving. Your help is very much appreciated!
