- Juniors: 15–19 (2007-2011)
- Seniors: 15 & Over (2007- older)

There will be direct finals for all events.

## CLUB ENTRY LIMITS

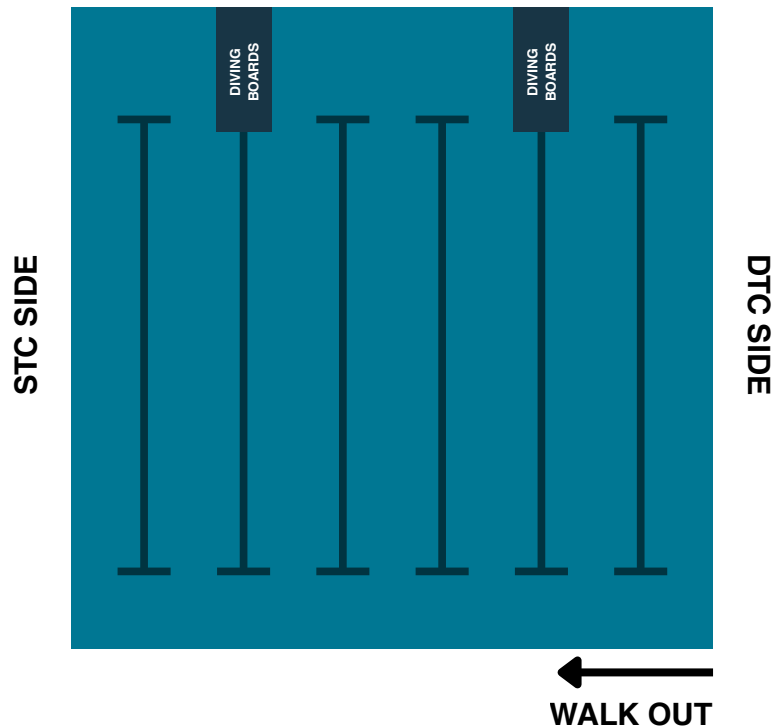

## Facility Information

**Food:** Teams are allowed to bring in their own food (no glass containers allowed).

Tables and tents/canopies will be available for rent (info to follow) and will be set up in advance in the team area.

**Gelling:** There will be a designated knocking station at the facility. Please do not knock anywhere else. There is to be no knocking or deknocking or washing out brushes/bowls in the bathrooms. If anyone does deknock in the bathroom or pool, there will be a \$100 fine per incident. The facility does not allow any deknocking onsite.

**Warm Up:** Several lanes will be available in the 50m for warm-up/cool-down. Based on final entries, there may be restrictions on times each event can be in those lanes.
