MEET WARM UP ASSIGNMENTS SATURDAY - MONDAY: DUE TO TEAM NUMBERS THE WARM UP WILL BE SPLIT INTO 2/ 45 MIN WARMUPS BY TEAM AND WILL BE ROTATED EACH DAY: 7:15 – 8:00 AM, 8:00 – 8:45 AM
OPEN WARM UP EACH DAY: 6:45 AM-7:15 AM

ALL TEAMS WILL SET UP OUTSIDE THE POOL DECK IN THE BACK

Teams may begin setting up tarps **after 3 pm on Friday**. School gets out at this time so please be respectful of the students and the facility. Teams are encouraged to bring their safe sport pop up tents for athlete changing.

Your tarps may be set up anywhere outside the deck as long as a fire lane (no tarps in the drive way area) is not blocked.

The bleachers will be designated for parents only- swimmers (no teams/swimmers and no tarps/chairs in the bleachers).

Coaches may set up tarps for themselves on either end of the pool.

Meet jobs have been assigned to teams- large teams may have multiple jobs.

Friday: All swimmers must provide their own timers and lap counters

This meet is positive check-in for Friday events.

Scratch deadline for Saturday-Monday events: Scratch deadline for Saturday, Sunday and Monday events will be **5:30 pm** for the next day's events in the Admin Office.

RELAY CARDS DUE: 11:00 AM each day

SCRATCH FROM FINALS: Swimmers may scratch from finals and must do so within 30 minutes of the announcement of the prelim results. Scratch book will be in the office.

HOSPITALITY: Will be provided for coaches and officials.

SNACK BAR: There will be a snack bar at the meet.

Any parent working as a volunteer is expected to be doing their job while on deck and not interacting with their swimmers, using a recording device or using their phone while their

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swimmer is racing or while they are timing or being a meet marshal. There is no photography behind the blocks or cell phone usage at the start end for an event.

Parents are only allowed in the bleacher area (not anywhere else on deck) unless they are timing or being a meet marshal. Parents may enter the bleacher area from the driveway or from the front of the pool. **Please respect the caution tape and signs.**

RESTROOMS: Athlete restrooms will be located up the stairs outside the back of the pool deck and the restrooms located inside the pool at the entrance. Parents and adult athletes are to use the restrooms under the bleachers outside the pool deck.

ANNOUNCING: We are limited to the announcing that we are allowed to do inside the pool deck. There will be a couple of speakers in the quad. We will post the seeding & results out in the back along with on the deck by the Admin office. Swimmers are responsible for checking the results that will be posted to see if they qualify for finals.

TIME TRIALS: Time Trials will be conducted on **Sunday only** for **swimmers entered in the meet** at a cost of **\$20.00 for each event**, provided there is sufficient time between the end of the preliminary session and the start of warm-ups for the final session, as determined by the meet referee. Time Trial entries will be taken on-site at the Admin Table.

Relay-only swimmers will be allowed to swim in time trials.

- The Time Trial entry deadline shall be one hour prior to the estimated/published conclusion of Sunday's preliminary session. The starting time for Time Trials will be determined by the Meet Referee.
- Time Trials events offered will include all events in the meet program with the exception of the distance freestyle events (500, 1000 and 1650) and the 400Y IM. Time Trials shall be swum in the order listed under the meet program.
- It is the swimmer's responsibility to provide timers for Time Trials.

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
