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Rules (Cont'd):	All safety requirements will be enforced for the well-being of our swimmers. In case the race needs to be abandoned, air horns and safety craft will direct the swimmers to shore. Once on the shore walk to designated meeting spot for transportation to the meet start, where swimmers will be directed to cover. Swimmer numbers are applied to the upper arms and the backs of shoulders. Please keep these areas free of sunscreen and oil.
	Other than Safety and Official's boats, no additional craft will be allowed near the race course. This is a non-escorted swim.
Athlete Eligibility:	For the general meet all swimmers and teams must be currently registered ATHLETE members of USA Swimming. Parent, Coach or Official members of USA Swimming MUST register for a One-Meet membership.
	 For an additional \$15 fee, non-USA Swimming athletes may register for a USA Swimming One-Meet Membership
	Only SC LSC registered swimmers are eligible to compete in the State Championship events. Age will be based on the swimmer's age on the first day of the meet.

	Each swimmer can enter up to 4 events. SC LSC Swimmers are eligible to enter the championship events and open events. Out of LSC and single meet USA-S members are only eligible to enter the open events.
Meet Format:	Meet management reserves the right to alter the timeline or make any other necessary changes during the meet to provide the best and safest competition environment for the athletes. All like-distances will be seeded as a single event, without regard to a swimmer's age or gender.
	The Meet Director reserves the right to assign participants to waves in each event if number of entries warrants. If waves are necessary, they will be based on gender and age.
	All races are out and back, swum along a buoyed line (kept to the right of the swimmers) that follows the east shore of Hartwell Lake. Buoys are placed every 100 meters along the course. Additional markers are placed at 50, 150 and 250 meters (half-K turn) to aid in the half-K. The finish shoot and line are clearly marked. At the 1K mark, the course makes a slight dog-leg left. At this point there is a set of two buoys forming a gate through which swimmers must pass on the out portion only of the 3K and 5K races. On the return portion, swimmers simply keep the course to their right.

Safety boats will monitor the entire course. Water and sports drink will be available on every boat on the course and at the turn. Swimmers must wear race cap, numbers on both arms and back for identification. Medical personnel will be on site.

For the 5K events, all swimmers who have not completed the course within 2½ hours will be retired. If the water/air temperature is above USA-Swimming's Rules the event will be shortened to a distance no longer than 4.5K.

For the 3K events, all swimmers who have not completed the course within 13/4 hours will be retired.

Entries: TEAM Entries:

For **team entries**, only electronic entries using Standard Data Interchange format (SDIF/SD3) will be accepted. 500 seed times must be listed to 1/100th second using short course yards times or with a no time entry.

Electronic files must be submitted by this deadline to **meetdirector@clemsonaquaticteam.org**. In order for your entries to be considered complete, the final Summary Sheet must be signed and e-mailed to the same address no later than 11:59 pm on May 30, 2018.

Your payment in full (checks payable to Clemson Aquatic Team) should be submitted to the Clerk of Course prior to the start of the first event.

Entries: INDIVIDUALS	If you are not a current USA Swimming Athlete member, you MUST register using the website below.
	For individual entries , individuals must complete an electronic entry form and pay their fee electronically. See: http://www.deathvalleyopenwater.org
	The entry deadline is 11:59pm on May 30 th , 2018. SC Swimming does not accept deck registrations. Swimmers must be registered by the entry deadline. <i>No day of the event registrations</i> will be accepted. It will be possible to add events on the day of the event up until the time of the pre-race meeting for that event at a cost of \$12/event.
Awards:	For the SC LSC Championship events, medals will be given to the top 10 SC Swimming places (Jim Keogh Senior 15-18 5K, Christine Jennings 13-14 5K, Jacque Grossman 11-12 3K and 10 & Under 1K). A SC LSC Championship team banner will be awarded to the overall SC team champion and plaques will be awarded to the 2 nd and 3 rd top scoring SC Teams. In addition, a Championship team banner will be awarded to the SC men's team champion and the SC women's team champion. A swimmer can place and score in only one championship event.
	All open events will receive awards as follows: Medals will be given to the top 3 finishers, by gender and age group (10&U, 11-12, 13-14 and 15-18, 19 &over). Places 4-10 will be awarded ribbons by gender and age.
	ANNA C SAMS 9.5K recognition will be given to anyone who completes all distances at the completion of the 0.5K. Anna was the first to swim and place in all events (0.5K, 1K, 2K, 3K and 5K for 11.5K total; note we no longer run the 2K event).
	Note that all awards (except the Anna C Sams) will be delivered within the weeks following the event (not on the day of the event) to give time for result verification. In the case of team entries, awards will be delivered to the respective coach. In the case of individuals, awards will be delivered to the individual.
Scoring Details:	SC LSC Championships will be scored according to the top 10 finishers in each event by gender as follows: 11,9,8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1, then totaled by team for team awards and recognitions. A swimmer can place and score in only one championship event.
Timing:	Timing is done by stopwatch.
Coaches Eligibility:	Coaches must check in at Clerk of Course and be able to show proof of current registration and certifications.
Other Information:	Hospitality for athletes after their swim is included in the entry fee. Concessions are available for sale to swimmers and spectators.

Directions:	From the North Take I-85 South to exit #19B (Hwy 76/28 West). Exit north, toward Clemson University. Follow Hwy 76/28 west for a while. Turn left at the 3rd signal (3.7 miles) after the Dairy Queen & Bi/Lo onto Perimeter Road (there is also a sign for South Carolina Botanical Gardens). Follow Perimeter around campus. After 1.2 miles on Perimeter you will go through your first signal. Then you will go through your second signal, pass the football stadium (on right) and Jervey Gym (on left). After traveling 2.1 miles on Perimeter, you will go through your third signal and past the building on the left (McFadden). Take your next left on East Bank Drive where the "Clemson Rowing" sign is (2.3 miles). East Bank Dr is the only road to the left before the next stop light at Hwy 93. East Bank will lead you past the baseball stadium (on the left), up a hill and to the boathouse.
	From the South Take I-85 North to exit #14 (Hwy 187). Turn left (north) on Hwy 187 toward Pendleton, and proceed approximately 6 miles until 187 ends at a traffic light. Turn left onto Hwy 76/28 west. Turn left at the 3rd signal (3.7 miles) after the Dairy Queen & Bi/Lo onto Perimeter Road (there is also a sign for South Carolina Botanical Gardens). Follow Perimeter around campus. After 1.2 miles on Perimeter you will go through your first signal. Then you will go through your second signal, pass the football stadium (on right) and Jervey Gym (on left). After traveling 2.1 miles on Perimeter, you will go through your third signal and past the building on the left (McFadden). Take your next left on East Bank Drive where the "Clemson Rowing" sign is (2.3 miles). East Bank Dr is the only road to the left before the next stop light at Hwy 93. East Bank will lead you past the baseball stadium (on the left), up a hill and to the boathouse.
