



THE RESULTS ARE IN

Thank you to the 180 parents and 421 athletes who took the time to complete the recent survey. Designed with the help of the Aspen Institute, its metrics have assisted our staff and coaches in bolstering environments for athletes to develop social, emotional, and cognitive skills. Our results look solid and good in every category measured.

The Net Promoter Score (NPS) is a market research metric that is based on a single survey question asking respondents to rate the likelihood that they would recommend a company, product, or a service to a friend or colleague. The NPS score question was, "On a scale of 0-10 how satisfied are you with your child's experience?"

- · Across the entire SWIM program the overall average NPS was 8.52 (parent) and 8.46 (athlete).
- · Across the entire DIVE program, the overall average NPS was 8.08 (parent) and 8.71 (athlete).

June was an exciting month for our Nadadores. With school ending, the Summer Schedule officially took effect, and swim and summer activities kicked into high gear.

The start of June had us hosting an Intrasquad meet, where our Nadadores got some long course racing and used it as a tune-up before our June Age Group Championships. It was a great opportunity for them to try different events and build confidence in long course racing. A highlight was the Mixed 200 Free Relay, where Victoria Mori, Nolan Baker, Darren Nguyen, and Gracyn Aquino broke the 15-16 National Age Group Record. Congratulations on this outstanding accomplishment!

In other news, **Zak Huey-Nazareno** swam three events at JAG and went two best times. One of them was the 1500 Free, and that was the first time he swam it. He went 29 seconds faster than what he was seeded at.

We also celebrated our Olympic Trialists and Olympic Qualifiers at the Pursuit of Paris send-off, a team-wide event that showcased the Nadador Way. **Teagan O'Dell and Noah Sech**, from our Senior Division, went on to compete at the Olympic Trials in Indianapolis, Indiana. Held in Lucas Oil Stadium, it was one of the largest swimming events in history. Noah competed in the 200m IM and 400m IM, while Teagan competed in the 100m and 200m backstroke. Teagan finished 10th in the semi-finals of the 100m backstroke and 8th in the finals of the 200m backstroke. **Both Noah and Teagan represented the Nadadores incredibly well, and their team is so proud of them both!**






TEAM PICTURES AND SIZING DAY - WEDNESDAY JULY 10!


