

SUMMER RACING BEGINS FOR THE NADADORES

Championship meet season kicked off for us in June, and our Nadadores wasted no time in putting up some impressive racing.

US Nationals was up first, and **Trenton Julian** had an impressive meet, finishing 3rd in the 200 IM with a lifetime best, 4th place in the 200 Fly, and 5th place in the 100 Fly. These results left Trenton with world rankings of 10th in the 200 IM, 14th in the 200 Fly, and 29th in the 100 Fly, but unfortunately just outside making the World Championship team for the US. Staying true to working his process, he is now right back in the water and focused on the TYR Championships in August.



Penny Oleksiak took over from there at the Canadian Trials and came away with two individual national championships in the process. The first was the 50 Free, in which she also posted her first sub-25 time ever. Then taking control from start to finish, Penny looked strong in the 100 Free and set herself up for two individual events in Singapore at the upcoming World Championships.



This leaves the Nadadores with four swimmers having qualified for the upcoming World Championships. Congrats and good luck to **Penny Oleksiak**, **Yeziel Morales**, **Stefano Mitchell**, and **Patrick Groters**!


