
PATRICK DALY

THE ROAD TO PARIS CONTINUES...

Our pros are now fully focused on and ready to race in their final meets along the Road to Paris. May brought the Nadadores some exciting news as **Penny Oleksiak** is the first Nadador to officially be invited to the Paris Olympics by being named on both of Canada's 4x100 relays (free and medley) and will have the opportunity to add the 100 Free individually in the month of June. We also have 3 athletes that are currently ranked to be invited for their countries: Jarod Hatch and Kayla Sanchez for the Philippines and Yeziel Morales for Puerto Rico. The qualifying period ends June 23 (the same day as the end of the US Olympic Trials), so we will know our official invites after that time. Congrats also go out to Yeziel Morales as he broke his own Puerto Rico national record in the 200 Back by nearly ½ a second!

The Nadadores were highlighted by a 1st and 3rd place finish by Avery Giese in the 1m and 3m event, a 1st and 3rd place finish by Taylor Fox in the 3m and platform competition, and a 1st place finish by Anna Lemkin in the platform competition.











DEVELOPMENTAL DIVING UPDATE

Nadadores Developmental program athletes are looking ahead to a jam-packed summer of dive education and competitions. Last week, many gained valuable competitive tips during the Perform on Purpose: Mental Conditioning for Champions seminar hosted by Nadador Olympian, Dr. Megan Neyer.

More than 70 divers qualified to Zones. They will continue to work current dive level lists with hopes to qualify to the 2024 USA Diving National Championships.

Novice 4, 3 & 2 have begun evaluations to assess progress through the competitive pathway. Progress reports track strengths and weaknesses for both the athlete and parent and serve as a roadmap to help plan for the next phase of training. These divers will also compete at the Lee Brennan Memorial Invitational on June 9th in Laguna Nigel. Many are close to JO dive lists and may compete those in this event.

The Gold Group High School divers wrapped up the High School season with impressive performances at Leagues and CIFs.

Many Gym 2 Dive athletes have now made the full transition to diving and most Blue group divers have made the transition to a two-day Novice group, which adds 30 minutes to each day's training. And Lessons divers have been focused on repetitions of dive skills on tramp and dry-boards, with many ready to take those skills to the water.

WORDS FROM COACH MARK

Indeed, We Shall Succeed! The essence of collective triumph?

It's quite straightforward - delight in the act of swimming and cherish every moment. At the Nadadores, joy is derived from self-truthfulness.

The pleasure of swimming emerges when we embrace and surmount challenges. It flourishes when swimmers treasure the possibilities it unfolds, when we acknowledge that the swimming journey is irreplaceable.
