
NADADORES WAY BRICKS ARE HERE

Over the past few weeks, our athletes have competed in League Finals, CIF Championships, and the California State Championships — and their hard work has paid off in a big way.

From across the Southern Section, over 40 Mission Viejo Nadadores earned qualification to compete in their respective CIF divisions. Our swimmers represented a variety of schools across Orange County and beyond, uniting under the common banner of excellence. Of the 40+ CIF qualifiers, an impressive 19 swimmers punched their ticket to the CIF State Championships — where our Nadadores rose to the occasion, delivering strong swims against the highest level of high school competition in the state.

As we wrapped up the month, our focus shifted to long course season with our May BB Min Meet and Speedo Grand Challenge. These meets served as great check points for our athletes as we continue preparing for our summer championship meets. We encourage all of our athletes to use the experience and

multiple finalists in several events with the highlight being Nadador coach and pro athlete Grayson Campbell winning his 6th Senior National Title with a 1st place finish in the Men's 3m Synchronized event. Grayson will be attending the World



Championships in Singapore with partner Jack Ryan.

who is finishing up her sophomore year at Indiana University. Ella placed 3rd on the Women's Platform Event earning her a position on the World Championship Team.


