It is a great "racing process" opportunity for our athletes, as these meets are held as short course meters competitions, and work on improving the racing from stop to stop.

Highlights from the Series

Stefano Mitchell joined us for the last stop, and did so in National Record fashion. Stef dropped his own 50 Free record (set back in 2021) and set a new Antigua and

Barbuda National Record by two tenths of a second (dropping a second from his personal best to do it.

Yeziel Morales also got in on the national record run, breaking his own Puerto Rico National Record in the 200 Back, twice, and finishing the series ranked 14th in the World.

Isa Odgers worked through a great "racing process", finishing the series with all bests at the final stop and current World rankings of 9th in the 400 IM, 15th in the 200 IM, and 26th in the 200 Breast.

Trenton Julian finished the series with an impressive 23rd overall, especially considering the challenges he faced, such as illness, and World Rankings of 6th in the 200 Fly, 12th in the 400 IM, 13th in the 100 Fly, and 14th in the 200 IM.

Her visit was a memorable moment that reminded us all to chase our goals with courage and heart.






DIVE DIVISION

DAVID COLTURI SHINES IN BOSTON

Nadador Coach and High Diver David Colturi capped off an incredible year of competition with a 3rd place finish in front of a home crowd at the Red Bull Cliff Diving World Series in Boston. Coming off surgery last December, David displayed his grit and resilience battling his way back to the upper echelon of the sport. Building off strong performances at the World Aquatics Championships, and High Diving World Cup, David executed 4 incredible dives averaging 8's from the judges to vault onto the podium. His 3rd place finish solidified his spot as a Permanent Diver for the 2026 Red Bull Cliff Diving World Series, an honor only extended to the top 8 athletes in the world.


