2018 Nevada State Championship

Sandpipers Depth on Full Display at State Meet

This past Veteran's Day weekend, more than 180 Sandpipers competed in the *Nevada State Championships* hosted at Heritage Park in Henderson. The Sandpipers dominated the meet with swimmers placing in high point in multiple age groups.

White 1 swimmers **Teagan Sacco** and **Lewis Bateman** represented our youngest age group with Sacco placing 2nd and Bateman placing 1st in high point for 8 and under. Brooklyn Smith placed 2nd in the 9-10 girls age group with Yellow 1 team **mate Riley Christensen** placing third. **Gabe Manteufel** placed 1st and **Jack White** placed 2nd for the boys 9-10 category. **Katie Grimes** and **Luke Ellis** took top honors in the 11-12 age group. National Age Group Swimmer **Caleb Kattau** also placed third within the boys 11-12 age group. Senior 1 swimmers **Arabella Sims**, 3rd, and **Brice Barrieault**, 1st, represented the Sandpipers in the 13-14 age group.

In addition to taking 11 of the possible 30 high point awards, three team records were broken over the course of the meet. **Katie Grimes** broke the only individual team record at the meet. Katie downed her own 11-12 girls 200 Freestyle record with a time of 1:54.11.

Two female relay records were also erased from the books. The first was

the 8-Under 100 Free Relay which stood for 16 years and 1 day! The team of **Jaylen Angelias**, **Lola Angotti**, **Makena Manteufel**, and **Teagan Sacco** took over 2.5 seconds from the old record. The second group of record breakers is a familiar sight in the record books. The team of **Bella Sims**, **Audrey Yu**, **Paige Kuwata** and **Kamika Francis** combined to break the 13-14 400 Medley Relay team record by more than 3 seconds.

Although team scores at the State Meet aren't officially kept, the Sandpipers clearly out swam the competition across all age groups. Our success on the State level was not possible without the time, effort and dedication each swimmer, family and coach has put in these past few months. The season isn't over just yet, so let's continue to work hard to achieve our goals!
