SANDPIPERS TAKE HOME JAG TEAM TITLE

69 Teammates Compete in Mid-Season Tune Up

The Sandpipers of Nevada traveled to La Mirada, California to compete in the 2017 June Age Group Invite and finished the meet in first place overall, ahead of 60 other teams in attendance.

The JAG Meet, used by most teams as their mid-season focus meet, saw Sandpiper teammates lighting it up throughout the course of the four day meet. In addition to tons of best times, finals qualifiers, and new qualifying times achieved, Sandpiper Teammates broke 22 team records! Individual team records were set by Nick Becker, Chloe Freeman, Paige Kuwata, and **Thomas Miller**. A full break down of the records can be found later in this issue, and on the team website.

Following the pool competition, the Sandpipers went on to race at the *JOs/Western Zone Open Water Championship* at Castaic Lake the next day. Over 30 teammates raced in 1K, 3K or 5K races.

Top 5 Finishers in their age group were Luke Ellis, Jesse Malmquist, Joseph Gutierrez, Sawyer Grimes, Dylan Gravley, Kate Grimes and Chloe Freeman.

Overall, it was a fun weekend for the Sandpipers. We did a great job stepping up and swimming fast. The coaching staff was thrilled to see our teammates behind each other's lanes cheering all weekend.

Centennial Hills YMCA and Skyview YMCA have been Sandpipers satellite pools for 2 1/2 years. Both sites offer levels 2 and 3 in each age group, designed to prepare swimmers in the North and Northwest for our level 1 groups at Desert Breeze. We have moved over 25 swimmers to Desert Breeze since the Sites opened.

Our Centennial Hills YMCA is currently getting ready for Central JOs at the end of the month. We are also setting goals to qualify for November's State Meet in Carson City. With each meet, we see more and more improvement and are excited to see what they will achieve the rest of summer and in the fall season.

Starting back on June 12th, the Sandpipers introduced our newest program at Skyview, *Intro. to Sandpipers*. The program is designed to bring new swimmers to our program by teaching them basic competitive swim technique and getting them ready for the Level 3 groups at Centennial. We currently have 25 swimmers in the program. In just a month, we have seen huge improvements from these new teammates and are hoping to move them into Yellow 3 and White 2 in August.

SANDPIPERS COMPETE AT SUMMER NATIONALS

Erica Sullivan to Represent the USA at World Juniors

Four Sandpiper teammates traveled to Indianapolis, Indiana in June to race at the 2017 Phillips 66 Nationals/World Championship Trials. Brennan Gravley, Carter Grimes, Reese Hazan, & Erica Sullivan represented the Sandpipers with the opportunity to swim for Team USA on the world stage later this summer. Grimes (200Fly), Hazan (200Back) and Sullivan (800Free) finished the meet with a team record, while Gravley chipped in two lifetime best times.

The highlight of the trip saw Erica Sullivan take 9th place in the 800m Free, which earned her a spot on the USA World Junior team. She will compete in the 800 & 1500 Freestyles at the *Fina World Junior Championships* at the end of August, in Indianapolis.
