☐ I will adhere to USA Swimming's rules and code of conduct.
☐ I will adhere to Swim Torrance's code of conduct, by-laws, and Safe Sport policies.
☐ I will display respect and sportsmanship for athletes and parents to follow.
☐ I will respect officials, admin, and volunteers, as well as the rules of any event.
☐ I will treat opposing coaches, participants, and spectators with respect.
☐ I will act with professionalism and dignity in a manner suitable to our profession.
☐ I will proudly wear the correct team uniform for practices, meets, and events.
☐ I will hold our team accountable in displaying good sportsmanship.
☐ I will coach with positivity and without derogatory comments or abusive language.
☐ Our team will win with humility and lose with dignity.
☐ I will treat every athlete fairly, justly, impartially, intelligently, and with sensitivity.
☐ I will always place the well-being, health, and safety of swimmers above all other
considerations, including developing performance.
□ I will continue to seek and maintain my own professional development in all areas in relation to coaching and teaching children.
□ I will always maintain a professional separation between coach and athlete.
☐ I will arrive before the start of practices and meets to ensure swimmer(s) safety.
☐ We will always have 2 coaches stay after practice with athletes until they are picked up
☐ I will not use audio-visual recording devices in the locker rooms or behind the blocks.
☐ I will respect all facilities and other property used during practices, meets, and events
☐ I will be in good standing with all coaching certifications with USA Swimming.
☐ I will protect our athletes and families by reporting any Safe Sport infractions.

Any complaints of a coach violating this code of conduct will be brought to the attention of his/her supervisor and/or the club's Board of Directors.
