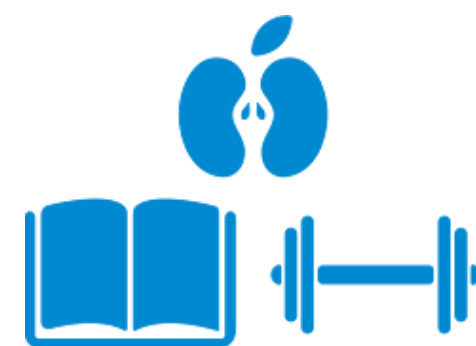
Our mission is to put Christian principles into practice through programs that build a healthy spirit, mind and body for all.
