Parent, Guardian, & Athlete Code of Conduct

1. Purpose

This Code of Conduct sets expectations for behavior that supports SEA's mission of excellence, inclusion, and integrity in competitive swimming. All athletes and parents/guardians are expected to uphold these standards at practices, meets, team events, and online.

Parent & Guardian Expectations

As a parent or guardian, I agree to:

- Support my child's participation in a positive and respectful manner
- Demonstrate good sportsmanship toward athletes, coaches, officials, and other families
- Communicate concerns constructively and privately with coaches or SEA leadership
- Refrain from coaching my child during practices or meets
- Respect meet protocols and refrain from entering restricted areas
- Uphold USA Swimming's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP)
- Avoid disruptive behavior, including yelling, profanity, or harassment
- Promote a safe and inclusive environment for all SEA members

Athlete Expectations

As an SEA athlete, I agree to:

- Treat teammates, coaches, officials, and competitors with respect
- Follow all team rules, practice expectations, and meet protocols
- Refrain from bullying, hazing, or exclusionary behavior
- Use appropriate language and behavior at all times
- Report any safety concerns or misconduct to a trusted adult or SEA Safe Sport Coordinator



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- Uphold USA Swimming's MAAPP and Safe Sport guidelines
- Represent SEA with pride, integrity, and sportsmanship

Violations & Consequences

SEA reserves the right to take disciplinary action for violations of this Code, which may include:

- Verbal or written warnings
- Suspension from practices or meets
- Removal from SEA activities or membership
- Referral to USA Swimming or law enforcement for serious violations
