EMAILS

- Make folders
- Reply to coaches

CALLS

- Take notes
- Be active
- Ask lots of questions

Visits vs. Recruiting Trips

- Big difference between the two
- Try to meet the coach on the visit, see facility, walk campus
- You HAVE to be invited to a recruiting trip
 - meet the team, spend the night, watch a practice

Talking to Coaches

- Have a list of questions to ask either through email or phone call
- Have an intro email written

NCSA

- Easy way to connect with coaches
- Makes it easier for the athlete

Doing it Yourself

- Have more control over the recruiting process
- Send out emails on your own time
- Could create more personal relationships
- Free

SWIMCLOUD

- Best place to find info on schools
- Pay the \$29 for a varsity account
- Don't send emails thru the website
