**HOST CLUB:** Ensworth Aquatics

#### LOCATION:

The Ensworth School 7401 Highway 100 Nashville, TN 37221

#### **FACILITY:**

The Ensworth School offers a 10-lane, 25-yard competition pool, with a 6.5 foot minimum depth, non-turbulent lane lines, a fully automatic electronic timing system, and a scoreboard with lane/time/place display. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.



#### **PARTICIPANT T-SHIRT:**

All participating athletes and coaches in attendance are eligible to get a free Marshmallow Mini T-Shirt. T-Shirts will *only be ordered for athletes and coaches for whom coaches have submitted order information.* The deadline for the T-Shirt Order is November 18, 2025.

Parents are also welcome to pre-order a t-shirt at the cost of \$20. Payment for extra shirts will be rolled into the Team Entry Fee. Participating Teams will be responsible for that payment at the time of Check-In. The order deadline will be the same as above. Orders should be submitted in EXCEL format and the form must include:

#### **RULES:**

- Unless otherwise noted herein, this meet shall be conducted in accordance with current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations.
- Please note that use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms.
- Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited.
- Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.
- In the interest of safety and accident prevention, coaches, officials and swimmers are asked to observe all posted pool rules and to conduct themselves in a safe manner. Only coaches, swimmers, officials, and volunteers will be allowed on deck.
- Chairs are permitted on the balcony overlooking the pool, but must be placed against the back wall, **not against the railing.**
- All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
- Coaches must show either current USA Swimming membership card or deck pass at coaches check in and make them available throughout the meet at the request of officials.
- 12 & UNDER TECH SUITS: No Technical Suit may be worn by any 12 & Under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet. A Technical Suit is one that has the following components:
  - a.) Any suit with any bonded or taped seams regardless of its fabric or silhouette; or
  - b.) Any suit with woven fabric extending past the hips



- Swimmers attending the meet without a coach must communicate with the meet director before the start of the meet for warm up placement with the host team.
- In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.
- Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
- Lifeguards will be on site during this event. Additional medical services will not be available on site.
- PARKING: A note will go to coaches just before the meet outlining parking and other facility information.

#### WARM UPS:

Southeastern Swimming Meet Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect at this meet.

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

USA Swimming registered athletes only may participate. Entries will not be accepted without current registration numbers. Coaches and officials must present evidence of certification (Card/DeckPass) as required by SES Swimming. A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine the age for the entire meet. On deck USA Swimming registrations are not permitted.



#### **DISABILITIES:**

Swimmers with disabilities are welcome and must complete the Information Form for Disabled Swimmers and return it with entries. Coaches are asked to check-in before the meet with the Meet Director for any accommodations. (see attached Disabled Swimmer Form)

#### **ENTRIES DEADLINE:**

Meet Entries, summary and release forms, and entry fees, including surcharges, must be received by the Entry Chair by 12:00 p.m. on **November 18, 2025**. No manual entries. All events will be pre-seeded.

#### 2025 WAIVER, ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND LIABILITY RELEASE
