Program Details

GPAC Swim School is a program designed to teach swimming and water safety skills to children three years old and up. The program is divided into three levels:

- □ **Beginner Level-** For swimmers with little or no experience.
- □ Intermediate Level- Swimmers will build their Freestyle and Backstroke skills.
- Pre-Competitive Level- Swimmers will build up endurance and work on their Breastroke. Upon completion of this level, the swimmer will be ready for the GPAC White Team.

Lessons are held at the **Pensacola State College** Pool (1000 College Blvd.)

Classes are held twice a week Mon. / Wed. or Tues. / Thur.

Classes are 40 minutes long for eight lessons.

Each session is normally \$80.[∞] however under this program the fee is \$40.[∞].

A \$50. Registration fee (good for 10 consecutive sessions) is required.

Classes are held at 3:30 p.m., 4:15 p.m., 5:00 p.m., and 5:45 p.m.
