

GPAC Practice Policies

Late Pick Up Policy

Swimmers should be picked up promptly from swim practice. Parents are asked to be very sensitive to the extra burden placed on the coaches when students need to be supervised after the end of the scheduled practice time. Please be considerate to the GPAC staff, picking up swimmers in a timely manner allows for your child's coach to honor their family and personal commitments after practice.

GPAC coaches or authorized club personnel will be responsible for registered GPAC swimmers for five (5) minutes at the conclusion of the scheduled practice time. This is true only if the swimmer remains inside the building and in the immediate area of the pool. If the swimmer exits the building, GPAC is no longer responsible for the swimmer.

GPAC recommends that parents instruct all swimmers to stay inside the pool area or building until such time as the parent picks up the child. Further GPAC recommends that the parent parks their car and comes into the building to pick up their child. This is true even if you are early to pick up your swimmer.

Occasionally there will be situations that arise that are unpredictable where a parent could be late. If this occurs please be sure to have your coach's cell phone number so that you may call them. Coaches will stay up to 10 minutes after the conclusion of practice. Staff members may NOT use their personal vehicle to transport the child away from a pool.
