The purpose of this code of conduct for coaches is to establish common expectations for all members of the coaching staff at Renegade Aquatics. It is to be used as a guide to promote a positive team environment, good sportsmanship, and athlete safety.

- At all times, adhere to USA Swimming's rules and code of conduct.
- Always place the well-being, health, and safety of swimmers above all other considerations, including developing performance.
- Set a good example of respect and sportsmanship for participants and spectators to follow.
- Act and dress with professionalism and dignity, in a manner suitable to our profession.
- Respect officials and their judgment and abide by the rules of our sport.
- Treat opposing coaches, participants, and spectators with respect.
- Instruct participants in sportsmanship and demand that they display good sportsmanship.
- Coach in a positive manner and do not use derogatory comments or abusive language.
- Win with humility and lose with dignity.
- Treat every athlete fairly, impartially, intelligently, and with concern.
- Always maintain a professional separation between coach and athlete.
 Continue to seek and maintain their own professional development in all areas in relation to coaching and teaching children.

Any complaints of a coach violating this Code of Conduct will be brought to the attention of the team's owner/head coach.
