



Return to Campus-Solano College Starting March 11

DART Swimming is an outside user group at Solano College. Our rental includes the pool facility, restrooms and locker rooms. Our insurance (USA Swimming, USA Water Polo and Lesson Insurance) covers our group while using the pool.

As an outside user group, it is our responsibility to follow all campus rules and regulations as well as maintain a clean and safe environment.

The pool is located near the gym entrance and 1700 building. There are two entrances to the pool while in use.

Pool Area-Swimmers

Swimmers must remain in the pool area once dropped off for practices. Swimmers can remain in designated areas prior to the start of their practices if they arrive early. They must remain in the pool area.

Swimmers will have a designated area for their belongings during practices. It is not advised to leave items in the locker rooms or restrooms.

Swimmers who are 12 and under should be picked up in the pool area or in the designated pick up spot.

Locker rooms and restrooms are off deck. Swimmers using locker rooms who are 12 and under must be accompanied by another swimmer or an adult. Swimmers can use the restrooms on their own regardless of age (deep end near the pool.)

Viewing Areas

Viewing areas are available during practices and lessons at Solano College. Shade covering will be available later this spring-however, we do not currently have our structures on deck as there are some small projects still to be completed.

Spectators are welcome to sit in the stands or on the deck area near the shallow wall of the pool. There are not currently any chairs at the pool, so spectators are invited to bring their own chairs.

Other areas of the deck are limited to coaches and swimmers so that the swimmers are giving full attention to the coaches, practices and their teammates.

Parking/Drop-Off and Pick Up

Swimmers can be dropped off and picked up in the round-a-bout area of campus. This is a drop off and pick up only, so cars should not park/wait in that area. Parents should communicate/time the pickups with their swimmers and the end of practices.

Swimmers can use the locker rooms following practices. The time in the locker room should be limited to no more than 15 minutes following practices.

Coaches will stay with swimmers waiting to be picked up. Please keep this within a 15 minute window following the end of scheduled practices.

Pool Covers

Swimmers and staff will be responsible for taking off and putting on pool covers when safe to do so. The staff will communicate any days that covers will not need to be put on following practices.

This is a responsibility for all designated groups. The covers will generally be put back on the pool by Age Group, Senior and National Development (along with staff.)

Parking area

Parking is available in the student parking lots on campus. We are designated Lot 5 as our parking area this fall (staff will park in this area.)

Please DO NOT park in the following:

Staff Parking spaces (this includes waiting in cars in these spots.)

Cosmetology parking spaces

Round-a-bout.

The access road behind the pool is off limits and should not be used. This is clearly marked with signage.

All cars that park on campus will require a parking permit. The parking permits are required for practices Monday-Thursday and Friday mornings. Parking passes are not required on Friday afternoons as well as weekends.
