

Safe Sport Chair Report – Rebecca Landre 5/24/17 BOD Meeting

SUMMARY: Safe sport is process. Sierra Nevada continues to make significant progress at doing everything possible to ensure the protection of our athlete members and sport from any kind of abuse. There are teams (CCA, Vacaville, SASO, Sierra Marlins, Dart-Sacramento, Rocklin Mavericks and WAC) that have reached out to me to train all of their parents, coaches and athletes on the Safe Sport program. They are working with their parent body to ensure that there is an updated and signed parent code of conduct, coach code of conduct, locker-room policy and social media policy. They are also actively participating with their commitment to Safe Sport Monday.

My role as the Safe Sport chair has evolved. My role in training parents, athletes and coaches is exclusive to what are the positive things that we should be doing to protect our athletes and coaches and what those rules are that protect swimmers. Everyone has a responsibility!

I traveled to Atlanta to assist with furthering the development of the Safe Sport training program with the Safe Sport chairs in the Southern Zone. This was an exceptional opportunity for me and I have been able to use some of those materials in Sierra Nevada.

As the Safe Sport Zone chair for the Western Zone, I traveled to Phoenix to further that training and to further develop the training materials for team Safe Sport coordinators.
