

TIMING GUIDELINES AND REQUIREMENTS

- There is no set hour limit for timing at swim meets.
- > Swim meets may be delayed due to any unforeseen situations Timers need to be flexible with the schedule.
- Finners will be assigned by rotation at each swim meet that your child is participating in. Or, you may sign-up in the website for the hour(s) that you prefer to time.
- You are responsible to show up or find your own replacement once you are assigned or committed to that time slot. You are responsible to complete/finish the entire assigned time.
- The coaches will have a timing sign-in sheet for the meet. Please sign-in before you go to your lane to time. If you do not sign-in on the sheet when you are assigned or committed to time, you will be considered a "no show" and NO SHOW PENALTIES will apply.
- ➤ The Timing Coordinator will keep record of the timing hours on a separate spreadsheet.
- The parent that is requested to fill-in for a "no show" parent shall have their timing hours applied to the 30 annual service hour requirement. (One and a half service hours will be applied to every one timing hour). In order to receive your credit, you must print your name, date & hours timed on the Timing Sign-in Sheet with the coaches.
- ➤ Parents that time over their 2 hour spot will receive one and a half service hours for every one timing hour.
- NO SHOW PENALTIES: A \$30.00 per hour charge will be posted on the same month in your swim team account for a no show.
