Below is important information for all swimmers and families regarding the Antonian College Preparatory High School Campus (ACP) and Pool.

The San Antonio Wave has contracted to lease the pool on the Antonian College Preparatory High School (ACP) campus for practice, and all Wave swimmers and family members are guests on the campus. The Wave has permission to use the pool area only, and does not have privileges in other areas of the campus. The Wave strives to be gracious and considerate guests of ACP. We appreciate your cooperation.

1. **Wave parking is only in the B parking lot.** Your swimmer will follow the walkway, behind the buildings, and down steps to pool area. Enter only at far end of pool near restrooms.
2. Wave swimmers should not enter the pool area unless a coach is present.
3. Parent/guardian must come into the pool to pick up all Freshman group swimmers after practice.
4. There are no locker rooms and no showers available on site. Swimmers are to change in restrooms; no deck changing allowed. Only one-piece bathing suits are allowed.
5. No Wave swimmer, parent, or siblings are to wander grounds or play in the fields. Stay off of the athletic fields. There will be no access to school buildings. ACP has lot of forested areas filled with critters, deer, porcupines, skunks, snakes, etc. There are wasp nests and poison ivy on the premises along with other dangers. Do not allow your children to roam off.
6. Parents are not allowed on the working pool deck during practice. Please remain in the bleachers.
7. Families may bring their own chairs, but must be kept off the working pool deck and in line with the bleachers. At the end of your practice session, all chairs and equipment must be taken home and the pool deck and surrounding areas should be left tidy.
8. No smoking on the school premises.
9. Parents are responsible for the behavior of their swimmers and their other children in attendance, and are expected to adhere to these Rules.
