The 2021 Meet Bids will be open today, August 17, to all teams that meet the minimum requirements. Teams interested in hosting a swim meet in 2021 must submit their meet bid by Friday, September 4, 2020.

BB Championships February 26-28 (Two Host)

BB Championships July 16-18(Two host)

Meet Host Eligibility

Teams must be in good standing with the FGC, must not have any pending fines. It is recommended that a meet host have a minimum of one starter and two-stroke and turns officials registered with their team before bidding on a meet.

Meet host responsibility

- All Meets must comply with all USA Swimming and FGC Standing Rules.
- They are required to publish FGC qualifying times in their meet announcement and heat sheets.
- Required to use the FGC meet template. Found on the FGC web site.
- Maintain the meet at a reasonable size to stay under USA Swimming 4 hour rule for 12 & under.
- Required to have the minimum one Referee, Starter, Administrative Official, and two Stroke and Turns judge.
- Required to send five days before the start of the meet, complete meet entry/registration file to the registration chair
- Required to submit a back-up file within seven days of the conclusion of the meet to the FGC times and record chairman

In granting this approval, it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming and Florida Gold Coast Swimming, Inc., shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising because of injuries to anyone of the event.

2021 Blackout Dates – By FGC Rules, blackout dates extend seven days before or seven days after each level championship meet. The FGC has also blacked out any meets from February 8-14, 2021.

Provisional Officials

In order to address the concern of having an adequate number of officials for intrasquad, dual, and virtual meets as the country re-opens, the Officials Committee has approved a temporary exception to the LSC certification requirements. This temporary exception allows individuals to be certified as Provisional Officials (PO) for a 60 day period and, as far as registration purposes are concerned, will be handled the same as Apprentice Officials. That is, the PO will not be required to complete a BG check, APT, CPT, or pay the registration fee.

Included with this document are:

- A table showing the Provisional S&T Official Recommendations
- The Provisional Official application form
- The step by step procedures that will be followed by the PO

USA Swimming Provisional S&T Official Recommendations: This document provides information as to the targeted audience for PO. Like the Apprentice Official, the individual does not need to be a registered member but might be. Additional candidates who are eligible are those who already have some knowledge of strokes such as YMCA or high school officials. The document also indicates the type of meets at which the PO can serve as an official as well as certification requirements.

Provisional Official Application Form: You will notice the strong resemblance to the Apprentice Official form. The name of the form was changed and places were added for the contact information of the LSC officials chair as well as the mentor who provided training. The LSC officials chair will maintain control of this form and provide it to the PO at the appropriate time.

Step to Certification of the Provisional Official: As the name implies, this document describes the actual process that will be followed by the individual interested in becoming a PO. The job of the registrar starts at step 7. The meet referee will take a picture of the application form ensuring that the first date of the meet is included and will send that picture to the LSC registrar for entering into SWIMS.

• If the individual already has an account in SWIMS, scroll all the way to the bottom of the record in the Edit screen where the Apprentice Office History is located. Click "Yes", enter the date of the session(s) worked, and save the record. (If the individual happens to already be listed as an official, you will need to change the membership code to "other".)



If the individual does not already have a record in SWIMS, add him/her as a Non-Member. This process will look exactly the same as adding a new member. This time the Apprentice Official fields will be in the middle of the page instead of at the bottom.

How to identify:

FINA-approved logo and no green checkmark and woven with bonded seams, it is a banned 12&U suit

FINA-approved logo with a green checkmark made of knit material with sewn and non-bonded seam, it is allowed

A few post-inventory suits may not have the green checkmark and could still be on an approved suit if it was purchased before the checkmark requirement

Tech Suit Restriction for 12-and-Under Swimmers by USA Swimming

Tech Suit Restriction for 12-and-Under Swimmers

The following rule, proposed by the Age Group Development Committee, will take effect September 1, 2020.

102.8 SWIMWEAR

- .1 Design
- F. No Technical Suit may be worn by any 12 & Under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet.
- 1) A Technical Suit is one that has the following components:
- a. Any suit with any bonded or taped seams regardless of its fabric or silhouette; or
- b. Any suit with woven fabric extending past the hips.

(Note: WOVEN FABRIC-A suit with woven fabric and sewn seams that does not extend below the hips is permitted.)

(Note: KNIT FABRIC-A suit with knit fabric and sewn seams not extending below the knees is permitted.)

This rule is in effect for all USA Swimming competitions in the United States, so any manufacturer or vendor selling a suit in the United States is subject to the above rule. No Technical Suits may be worn by any 12-Under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet.

A Technical Suit is one that has the following components:

Any male or female suit with any bonded or taped seams is defined as a technical suit regardless of its fabric or silhouette.

*Bonded Seam

*Sewn Seam
TechSuitSeamGood250x250

Any male or female suit with woven fabric and to the knee or mid-thigh is defined as a technical suit regardless of the type seams: bonded, taped or sewn. (Note: A woven suit with sewn seams and in a male brief or female regular cut not to the knees is not defined as a technical suit and is not restricted).

Compliant Suits:

Checkmark

Any suit that does not have the FINA logo on it is approved for 12-Under use.

There are a handful of suits in the market that have the FINA logo that would be considered legal for age group competition because they do not meet the definition of what is deemed a technical suit. These suits and only these suits will bear an additional check mark logo developed by USA Swimming to indicate that the suit is complaint with the rule. This check mark will be placed to the left or right of the FINA logo on the suit. A picture of the check mark logo is next to this paragraph

Suit Manufacturer Feedback:

Suit manufacturers have a vested interest in both this legislation and future growth of the sport. Virtually all the manufacturers agree that the high end/highest cost tech suits are not appropriate for use by younger swimmers. Manufacturers have provided significant input during the process of defining tech suits and have been given a reasonable lead-up time to adjust product lines and have agreed to adapt to the proposed restrictions. All major brands in the USA market were actively involved in this process and 14 manufacturers overall were consulted.










