Florida Swimming (FL) values its partnership with USA Swimming and is an active participant in numerous national programs.

Florida Swimming is part of the Southern Zone which is comprised of 15 separate local swim committees (LSC) located in the southern quadrant of the United States. FL governs the sport of swimming from the Apalachicola River and including Gulf County, except for the counties of Palm Beach, Broward, Miami-Dade, Monroe and the part of Hendry east of Route 8333. FS is then broken out to 6 Areas.
