

Border LSC Meet Personnel and SafeSport Requirements
(effective beginning 2023 Long Course Season)

USA Swimming Sanctioned swim meets are complex activities that require many certified and trained individuals. Beginning on the effective date above, in order to bid for a Border Swimming sanctioned meet the host team(s) must have at least three (3) of the following certified or trained individuals identified and committed for each competition pool prior to the bid submission:

- Starter
- Admin Official
- Three (3) Stroke and Turn Officials *(this counts as one item to meet the requirement)*
- Hytek Computer Operator
- Colorado Timing Console Operator

Teams that are having trouble meeting, or do not have the population to meet, these requirements are strongly encouraged to partner together on meets. This partnership is to be negotiated among the teams and not to be mediated by Border Swimming.

In addition to the above requirements, host teams that meet these requirements and are SafeSport recognized will be given first choice on meet weekends. Team seniority will no longer be a deciding factor on the meet weekend bidding process. After the SafeSport recognized teams have locked in their weekends, the bidding will open up to the remaining host teams that meet the requirements. One year after the effective date above, SafeSport recognition is required in order to bid on a Border Swimming swim meet. Teams have the right to bid for a meet with permission from the border general chair based on extenuating circumstances.
