Approval of Fall House of Delegates Meeting Minutes as read: Moved/Seconded/Passed

Bobby Livesay – Finance Vice-Chair: Financial reports presented – see attached.

Caroline Ezell – Athlete Representative:

Caroline honored the memory of Maddie Jackson.

It was reported that during the athlete meeting, the 12&U swimmers approved of the Sunday morning relays during the short course championship meet.

New athlete board members are Kaitlyn Brandenburg, Katherine Bellware and Nicolas Albiero.

Dave Doolin – Senior Vice-Chair:

The new USAS Futures meet will be added to the list of meets eligible for travel fund reimbursement.

Laura Kehrt – Technical Planning:

The Long Course Time Standards were presented. In the girls' events, there was an overall decrease in lowering the standards. The maximum decrease was 1%. Standards will be published after the HOD. Unattached athletes entering in KYLSC championship meets must have competed in two (2) KY Swimming sanctioned meets during each championship season: Short Course – September 1 to the cut-off date for eligible time and Long Course – April 1 to the cut-off date for eligible times. An athlete may appeal and request approval for exigent circumstances: for example, relocating to Kentucky from another LSC, to the board of directors. The board of directors may approve or decline the request.

Amy Albiero – Coaches Representative:

Coach Mentor Program: Kentucky Swimming applied for the USAS Coach Mentor Program Grant. If awarded, the kick-off event will be scheduled the weekend of Fall HOD. Last year's program was very successful.

Age-Group Coach of the Year: During the coaches meeting, Lewis Misinay with Lake Cumberland Swim Team was named Age-Group coach of the Year.

Zone Team Coaches: Lindsey Pfoff is the head coach for the 2015 S Zone meet. 2 more coaches are needed.

Open Water Zone Team: The LSC needs a coach for the S Zone Open Water Championship Meet. AllStar and Zone Head Coaches: As stated in the KY Swimming Handbook, the Age-Group Coach of the Year is the designated head coach for the MidState AllStar team and the Senior Coach of the Year is the designated head coach for the S Zone team. When those positions are declined, an application process for interested coaches will be available.

Mavi Sampaio - Records Chair:

A new process for updating records has been implemented. Instead of relying on coaches to submit new records forms, Technical Planning will provide monthly Team Manager reports that will be compared against USA Swimming Top Times reports. Any new records found will then be updated.

Jim Bellware - Rules Chair:

The Board of Directors will look into forming a committee for 2015-2016 to improve and streamline championship meet information, procedures and rules.

Mike DeBoor - General Chair:

Mike was approached to combine the Long Course Championship meets. This was presented to the board where there was discussion. Without facilities in the same location, it is too hard to run two meets during the same weekend.

S Zone Age-Group Championship Meet: The cost per athlete for the 2015 meet is set at \$800 per athlete.

Open Water: The KYLSC Open Water Championship meet will be a qualifier for the S Zone Open Water Championship Meet.

S Zone Open Water Championship Meet: Families will be responsible for transportation and accommodations. KY Swimming will pay entry fees and will provide financial assistance comparable to what is provided for S Zone Age-Group Long Course Championship Meet.

Short Course Venues: Other than reducing the size of the meet, there are really no other options.
