# S Zones Open Water Championship June 3-5, 2016

The kids swam pretty well this weekend. The meet, however, was one of the worst run races I've ever experienced. None of the meet information provided but the host was correct, changes were made willy-nilly to start times and race distances. The format of the Friday night relays was so poorly communicated that every coach had to re-do entries on the fly. The results were incomplete at best, and today the only reason they could score the pursuits at all was because an NC coach was actually recording finishing times and positions by hand on his own. For the caliber of competition at this meet, the production was a total joke.

For their lack of experience with open water (I believe Kaya Winchell was the only one who'd ever really done any OW racing before), I'm fairly pleased with how the kids performed, especially today in the pursuits. By their 3rd race of the weekend, most were really starting to grasp the concepts of sighting and drafting and how doing them well can provide a massive benefit. They were also starting to adopt the mindset necessary to be successful in open water swimming. The idea of physical contact and waves and current threw many of them for a loop on Friday and even Saturday. Wrapping their brains around this being closer to rugby than to pool swimming is something they all need to work on, but their we're starting to get it by the end of the weekend. The kids and families were all great, though, and put up with the nonsense at the meet with a happy face.
