Minutes from Fall 2011 HOD Meeting: motion/approved as read

Ben thanked Elizabethtown Dolphins for hosting the HOD meeting.

**Executive Secretary:** Year to date number of athletes-2,551. There have been a few changes made to the registration procedure for 2012-2013. Please read registration material as it is sent out. There have also been changes made to the pre- and post- procedure for meets, so for clubs hosting a meet, please read new sanction application instructions.

**Finance Chair**: Finance report was reviewed. It was asked what plans were being made to supplement income besides increasing athlete fees. Kent Pleasants informed the house that he, along with technical planning, is working on a five-year plan. The LSC has applied for one grant and looking into others. Motion moved by Mike Essig and seconded to accept the March 31, 2012 Financial Report/approved.

Conoco Phillips Award: Bucky Stoess was presented with the Conoco Phillips Service Award.

Administrative Vice-Chair: no report

**Senior Vice-Chair:** Dave Doolin reported that LY Swimming was asked by a representative of the Bluegrass States Games to take over the swimmer portion of the Games. Amy Albiero explained that if KY Swimming didn't help, the swimming events would probably be discontinued. At this point, the goal is to keep it alive. It could possibly be collaboration between a host club and KYLSC, sharing the revenue. Bonnie Roman felt this was another opportunity to promote KY Swimming.

**Age-group chair:** Amy Albiero reported he was getting ready for Zones. The coaching staff includes Nate Knopf, Pedro Pereira, Lindsey Hayden, Jenna Elchhorn, and Rich Tobergte. Quad team finished 2<sup>nd</sup> overall with several state records broken at the meet.

**Program development:** Nate Knopf reported that there will be a new application procedure for requesting Observed Meet approval. The goal is to streamline the procedure and make it as easy on the host clubs as possible.

**Technical Planning:** Laura Kehrt reported that the long course state championship meet will follow the same format as in 2011 with the following change: The 200 Free and 200 Medley relays will replace the 800 free relay in the prelim session on Sunday. It was asked what plans were being made to control the water temperature. Coach Mavi indicated that there is already a plan in place if there is a problem with the temperature.

The dates for the short course championship meets are set but tentative until the fall HOD meeting. 12&U – March 15-17 and 13&O – March 22-24

**Coaches Representative:** Jeremiah Heath asked new coaches to the HOD introduce themselves. Rich Tobergte with BOLT/MYST and Brian Thomas with WKU stood. During the coaches' meeting a KYLSC Coach Education Program was discussed. The program would offer continuing education opportunities by providing resources, webinars and mentors.

**Athletes Representative:** Paige Ezell introduced herself as the new Senior Athlete Representative. Ashley LeClair was voted in as new Junior Athlete Representative. During the athletes' meeting, posters for the USA Swimming Safety Poster Contest were created. Paige asked all HOD attendees to vote on their favorite. The winner's poster will be submitted to USA Swimming.

Safety Chair: no report

**Officials Chair:** Julie Floyd reported that 232 officials have been recertified, and 11 new officials have been certified. In December at Nationals, 3 officials from Kentucky worked the meet.

**Records Chair:** Mavi Sampaio reminded coaches to submit records forms when an athlete broke a state record. YTD -25 records broken; 6 relays, 19 individuals, 12 girls and 13 boys.
