Joseph Phillips, General Chair called to the meeting order at 7:32 pm.

JJ Rodgers motioned/Becky Gilpatrick second/approved meeting agenda as presented.

The September 14, 2022, minutes not available and will be reviewed at next meeting.

Finance Chair – Bobby Livesay

2021-2022 Financial Reports were presented – see attached. **Kevin Ryan motioned/Brent Runkle seconded/approved to accept the 2022-2023 end of the year financial report.**

2022-2023 Budget was presented. The KYLSC House of Delegates members who registered to vote at the September 24 HOD will be emailed the budget and submit their vote of approval by way of a Google document.

2022 USAS House of Delegates General Business Meeting

- The 120-day wait period for transfers was reduced to a 60-day wait period.
- January 1, 2023, for sanctioned meets, it will be required that sanctioned meets must have two meet marshals, one of each gender. Lesa Boone asked USAS if it was a requirement and was told that it was up to every LSC to make their own rule to enforce the requirement.
- David Barnes will reach out to USAS Rules and Regulations for clarification on the meet marshal requirements.
- The meet announcement must contain a description of the medical supervision (e.g., lifeguards, EMT, AED device, etc.) available to athletes participating in the meet.

2022 Southern Zone House of Delegates Meeting

- The Senior Zone Championship has been changed from a 4 1/2-day to a four-day meet.
- The Age Group Zone Championship has been changed from a 4 ½-day meet to a 3 ½ day meet. The age groups will consist of 11-12 and 13-14. The 15-18 age group has been removed from the format.
- The S Zone Age Group meet fees have been increased:
 - \$10 individual
 - \$15 relays
- \$5 surcharge add to Senior and Open Water championships
- S Zone Dues reconfigured. LSCs will be charged 10¢ per premium and non-athlete member.

Age Group Chair Report: Nick Graves

• Nick clarified that for the S Zone Age Group Championship, the number of athletes eligible will stay the same, 48 athletes. Each age group, 11-12 and 13-14 will increase

Coach Representative Report: Kevin Ryan

Kevin will reach out to LSC coaches with an overview of the new USAS requirements.

Officials Chair Report: Becky Gilpatrick

 17 clinics have been scheduled with half being clinics for new officials. Becky is tracking 54 new officials working towards certification.

SafeSport Coordinator Report: Lesa Boone

Lesa stated that USAS is putting the responsibility and liability of SafeSport onto the LSCs.

- Meet Marshals need to be two deep when monitoring locker rooms.
 To protect the adults volunteering as Meet Marshals, it will take more than clubs just listing that they have two meet marshals on deck.
- Medical supervision: Lifeguards don't necessarily count medical supervision. The liability is on the volunteers assigned as that person.
