LOCATION: Bowling Green High School Natatorium, 1801 Rockingham Lane Bowling Green, KY 42103

FACILITY: The Competitive Indoor Pool is 11 Lanes x 25 Yards. The seating for spectators is 400. The meet will utilize 8 lanes for competition with 2 lanes for warm-up/warm down. Colorado Timing System will be utilized with an 8 Lane Scoreboard and Colorado Backstroke wegdes

POOL MEASUREMENTS: The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4).

WATER DEPTH: The depth of the pool at the start end is 12 feet. The depth at the turn end is 4.6 feet.

MAAPP: All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. Use of audio or visual recording, including a cell phone, is not allowed in changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms. Such devices being used in these areas are subject to confiscation.

COVID-19: We have taken enhanced health and safety measures for the swimmers, coaches, volunteers, spectators and other meet workers. You must follow all posted instructions while attending this event. An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and individuals with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable. Neither USA Swimming, Inc. nor Kentucky Swimming , Inc., can prevent you (or your child(ren)) from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 while participating in USA Swimming sanctioned events. It is not possible to prevent the presence of the disease. Therefore, if you choose to participate in a USA Swimming sanctioned event, you may be exposing yourself to and/or increasing your risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19

Permitting a swimmer to attend this meet constitutes a representation by that swimmer's parent or guardian that the swimmer has not been tested positive for COVID-19 in the two weeks preceding the meet, that the swimmer has not been in close proximity to any person who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the two weeks preceding the meet, and that the swimmer is not exhibiting any signs of illness. All coaches, officials,

volunteers, spectators, & staff will be required to wear face coverings while in the facility. Swimmers will be required to wear masks unless actively warming up or competing. Swimmers will wear their face coverings up to the blocks and can remove prior to the start of their events.

DECK CHANGING: Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. Per USA Swimming Code of Conduct 304.3.7, persons violating this provision are subject to ejection of the facility.

BULLYING All participants and competitors shall follow the U.S. CENTER for SAFESPORT rules for bullying found on the USA Swimming and Kentucky Swimming websites. A violation will be grounds for removal of member from the facility.

DRONE USE: Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair. USA Swimming article 202.4.9 J

UNSUPERVISED SWIMMERS: USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. Swimmers participating under the provisions of 202.6 or USA Swimming's "open border" policy must be under the supervision of their coach or a USA Swimming member coach. Coaches who are entering swimmers but will not be at the meet should arrange ahead of time for another coach to supervise their athletes. Swimmers unaccompanied by their coaches or for whom arrangements have not been made must contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee who will assist the athlete in finding coach supervision.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS: Swimmers may enter up to 5 individual events and 1 relay per day. Entries will be taken on a 1st come, 1st served basis and will close at a max of 250 swimmers per session. ENTRIES: Entries should be submitted in Short Course Yards . Only Hy-Tek electronic entries will be accepted.

DECK ENTRIES: Deck entries for swimmers not already in the meet will not be allowed. Deck entries for swimmers already entered in the meet will be accepted if there is an open lane. Additional heats will not be added to the meet for deck entries. Deck entry fees are \$10, payable at the time of entry into meet.

ELIGIBILITY: Swimmers must be current athlete members of USA Swimming as provided in Article 302 or as provided under 202.6 or USA Swimming "open border" policy. Age is as of the first day of the meet. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

SWIMMERS WITH A DISABILITY: Entries for swimmers with a disability should be handled in the following manner: (1) enter the swimmer in the Hy-Tek database (or on the regular entry form); (2) list in the email accompanying the Hy-Tek entry file (or on a separate sheet of paper) the name of the swimmer, the stroke(s)/distance(s) s/he wishes to swim, the entry times, the day/session s/he wishes to swim the event(s), and the manner in which s/he prefers to be seeded (with a longer distance or with a different age group); and (3) provide any information about special accommodations needed by the swimmer. The final determination of seeding will be made by the Meet Referee after consultation with the swimmer and his/her coach.

CONDUCT: The meet will be conducted according to the rules set forth in the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations. All events will be timed finals.. Heats will be swum slowest to fastest.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded to $1^{st} - 8^{th}$ place. Relays will be awarded $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$ place for 12 and unders. Age Group High Points 6 & unders, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & Over

ADMISSION COST: No Admission will be charged

HEAT SHEETS: \$5.00 session

RESULTS: Will be posted on www.KYLSC.org. Teams can be emailed results.

SAFETY/WARM-UP: Coaches must maintain contact with their swimmers during warm-up. All entry into the pool for warm-up is feet first from the starting block end of the pool. There is no diving during warm-up, except in designated sprint lanes.

COACHES: Coaches must be current coach members of USA Swimming and must present credentials upon request

OFFICIATING OPPORTUNITY: SKY Swimming welcomes anyone who is a USA Certified Official to aide in officiating the meet. Official's Meeting will be held 45 mins prior to each session.

TIMERS: Visiting teams may be requested to provide timers based on swimmers entered into the sessions. 500 Freestyle Swimmers will be required to provide their own counter. 1000 & 1650 Freestyle Swimmers will be required to provide their own counter & timer

HOSPITALITY: There will be hospitality for coaches and officials throughout the meet.
