USA Swimming Rules	At a sanctioned competitive event, all USA Swimming athletes must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach. Arrangements for coach supervision must be made in advance of the meet.
	<ul> <li>Any swimmer entered in the meet <u>must</u> be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> </ul>
	The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
	Use of cameras, cell phones or any other recording device is not permitted immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) during race starts, competition and warm-ups.
	<ul> <li>Deck changing is prohibited. Per USA Swimming Code of Conduct 304.3.7, persons violating this provision are subject to ejection from the facility.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.</li> </ul>
	Flash photography is not permitted at the start of any race.

This includes participation as a member of a relay.</li> <li>All participants and competitors shall follow the US Center for SafeSport rules for bullying found on USA Swimming and Kentucky Swimming sites. A violation will be grounds for removal of member from the facility.</li> </ul>
