LOCATION: The Pavilion - Georgetown Scott County Parks & Rec; 140 Pavilion Drive; Georgetown, KY 40324

**FACILITY:** The competitive swimming pool measures 8 lanes by 25 yards; fully automatic timing system. Timing for 25's will utilize the timing system with swimmers starting off the side of the pool if certified; otherwise they must start in the water at the shallow end.

PARKING: Parking is available in the front parking lot of the Pavilion; the Pavilion parking lot is available at no cost.

**POOL MEASUREMENTS:** The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

WATER DEPTH: The depth of the pool at the start end is 12 feet. The depth at the turn end is 4 feet.

#### **RULES**

**Unsupervised Swimmers:** USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. Swimmers participating under the provisions of 202.6 or USA Swimming's "open border" policy must be under the supervision of their coach or a USA Swimming member coach. Coaches who are entering swimmers but will not be at the meet should arrange ahead of time for another coach to supervise their athletes. Swimmers unaccompanied by their coaches or for whom arrangements have not been made must contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee who will assist the athlete in finding coach supervision.

The use of audio or video recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Vice President of Program Operations.

**Deck Changing: prohibited**. Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in the locker rooms or other designated areas or "deck changing" is not appropriate and is prohibited.

**Athlete Protection Policy:** Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), will govern this meet. All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

**Deck Access:** Only athletes entered in the meet, working coaches, officials, and meet workers are allowed behind the blocks and in the designated areas for swimmers. There will be limited seating for spectators on deck.

**ENTRY DEADLINE:** The due date for entries, electronic or otherwise, is **Sunday, September 24th by noon**. Entries will be accepted up to the start of the meet

**ENTRY FEES:** Individual events \$6.00, Relay events \$10.00; plus a \$2.50 per swimmer KYLSC surcharge; plus \$12.50 per swimmer facility surcharge. \$10.00 per individual deck entry, only swimmers already registered and accepted at the discretion of the Meet Referee; payable at the meet. Please make checks payable to **GSCS**.

**ENTRY LIMITATIONS**: Each swimmer may enter a maximum of five individual events per day. Breaks will be taken where feasible to attempt to provide at least 15 minutes between each event.

**DECK ENTRIES**: Accepted at the discretion of the meet referee.

ELIGIBILITY: Swimmers must be current athlete members of USA Swimming as provided in Article 302 or as provided under 202.6 or USA Swimming "open border" policy. Age is as of the first day of the meet, Sept. 29th.

Coaches must be current coach members of USA Swimming and must wear credentials during the meet.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Please make all entries in short course yard times.

Only electronic entries will be accepted (Hy-Tek or SDIF). Handwritten, telephoned, or faxed entries will not be accepted with the exception of the report sheet provided for utilization when entering swimmers with a disability. If the USA Swimming ID for any swimmer is omitted, that swimmer's entries will not be accepted.

**SWIMMERS WITH A DISABILITY**: Entries for swimmers with a disability should be handled in the following manner: (1) enter the swimmer in the Hy-Tek database (or on the regular entry form); (2) list in the email accompanying the Hy-Tek entry file (or on a separate sheet of paper) the name of the swimmer, the stroke(s)/distance(s) s/he wishes to swim, the entry times, the day/session s/he wishes to swim the event(s), and the manner in which s/he prefers to be seeded (with a longer distance or with a different age group); and (3) provide any information about special accommodations needed by the swimmer. The final determination of seeding will be made by the Meet Referee after consultation with the swimmer and his/her coach.

**CONDUCT:** The meet will be conducted according to the rules set forth in the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations. Events will be contested in a short course yards pool. All events are deck seeded and timed finals. Heats will be swum slowest to fastest. Fly-over starts may be used at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

**CLERK OF COURSE/TEAM PARENTS:** Clerk of course may be used for 10&U events.

RESULTS: Will be posted on www.KYLSC.org and on meet mobile. Teams will be emailed results and data files.

**AWARDS:** Ribbons will be given to the top 8 finishers in all 10&U events. High point awards will be given to the swimmers with the highest point totals in the 8&U, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14 and Open age groups.

**CONCESSIONS/HOSPITALITY:** There won't be concessions provided at the meet other than the vending machines just outside of the pool area. Panera breakfast and coffee will be available in the hospitality room for coaches and officials on both Saturday and Sunday mornings. Drinks and snacks will be available to coaches and officials.

**SAFETY/WARM-UP:** Coaches must maintain contact with their swimmers during warm-up. All entry into the pool for warm-up is feet first from the starting block end of the pool. There is no diving during warm-up, except in designated sprint lanes.

**COACHES:** Coaches must show USA Swimming certification in order to receive their coach's packet. There will be a coaches' meeting 15 minutes prior to the start of the first session of swimming competition. There will be an official's meeting 30 minutes prior to the start of each swimming session.

**OFFICIATING OPPORTUNITY**: There will be an officials meeting 30 minutes prior to the start of each session. Please contact the meet referee, in advance of the meet if at all possible to let us know of your availability.

All meet directors, referees, starters and stroke and turn judges, serving in an official capacity must be members of USA Swimming or other FINA-member organizations. Except for coaches accompanying athletes participating under the provisions of 202.6 or USA Swimming's "open border" policy, all persons acting in any coaching capacity must be members of USA Swimming.
