The pool and parking lot is along that street.

SCHEDULE:

TIMED FINALS: SATURDAY, DECEMBER 6. 2025

Warmups: 8:00 AM EST

Meet Start: 10:00 AM EST

(may be adjusted due to number of swimmers)

FORMAT: This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current NFHS & KHSAA Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional, and exceptions are herein stated.

ENTRIES: Entries will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis until we have reached a maximum of 300 swimmers.



<u>Per KHSAA Guidelines</u>, entries are required to be submitted electronically and be generated using Hytek Meet Manager, Hytek Team Manager, or Hytek Team Manager Lite. Entry files are to be emailed to the Meet Entry Chair, Robyn Brandenburg, etdolphinentries@gmail.com <u>by 5:00 PM EST/4:00 PM CST on Tuesday, November 18, 2025.</u>

Ensure the school's name and code are listed according to the KHSAA listing on the website. Athlete's full name and grade are to be included in the entry. The **GRADE** is the **NUMERIC YEAR** in school (11, not JR). Include grade for all athletes.

ENTRY RULES FOR TEAM:

- A. Four (4) swimmers per event, for the 200 Free, 200 IM, & 500 Free.
- B. Unlimited swimmers in the 50 Free, 100 Free, 100 Fly, 100 Back, 100 Breast.
- C. Be sure to include the swimmers best time in the entry file for seeding purposes.

INDIVIDUALS:

A. Four (4) events per swimmer, with no more than 2 individual events.

RELAYS:

- A. Two (2) relays per team.
- B. Be sure to include the relay teams' best time in the entry file for seeding purposes.
- C. Eight (8) individuals may be designated and shall not count as an entry unless the competitor competes in that event. These swimmers must be designated in the entry file.
- D. Relay Cards shall be submitted at the specified time and place prior to the start of the event.
- E. Only the 4 swimmers designated on the relay card when due on competition day, including the designated lead-off swimmer are allowed to be behind the starting block.

TIME STANDARDS: No time standards at this time.

ORDER OF EVENTS: We will follow the NFHS order of events. No Diving. We will take breaks during the meet for warm-up/cool down purposes. Small breaks around the relays as well to help with the number of athletes behind the starting blocks.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION: For athlete protection, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including but not limited to cell phones, is not permitted in changing rooms, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Such devices being used in these restricted areas will be subject to confiscation.

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or restrooms is deemed unsportsmanlike and is strictly prohibited. (NFHS 1-5-2, 3-6-1d)

On-site shaving is prohibited at the competition site.

ATHLETE ENTRY FEE:

A \$10.00 fee per participant will be due to the Meet Director prior to receiving the final coach's packet at the start of the meet on Saturday, Dec 6, 2025, The fee will be based on the entries submitted on **November 18, 2025.**

WARM-UP: A warm-up schedule will be emailed to coaches prior to the start of the meet.

TIMERS: Teams will be contacted for required timers per team if required.

ENTRY TO DECK: Only Officials, KHSAA Coaches and Designated Volunteers are allowed on deck.

COACHES' MEETING: A brief coach's meeting will be held at the conclusion of warm-ups the day of the competition.

OFFICIALS' MEETING: Saturday, December 6, 2025 @ 9:00 AM EST in Hospitality.



SAFETY NOTES:

- 1. Coaches will instruct their swimmers regarding safety guidelines and warm-up procedures.
- 2. Coaches shall remain near the starting end of the pool when starting swimmers on sprint or pace work.
- 3. Coaches are required to actively supervise their swimmers throughout the warm-up session.
- 4. Appointed safety marshals have the authority to remove from the deck for the remainder of the warmup session any swimmer or coach who is in violation of safety guidelines or warm-up procedures.
- 5. Swimmers shall not jump or dive into the pool to stop another swimmer on a recalled start.
- 6. Swimmers are required to exit the pool at the conclusion of their warm-up session to allow adequate time for the other swimmers.
- 7. Warm up procedures shall be enforced during any breaks, scheduled or otherwise, during the competition.

HOSPITALITY: Hospitality room will be open to **coaches and officials** during the meet.

ADMISSION: Gate will be **cash only** \$8 entry (includes heat sheet).

HEAT SHEETS: Included with gate fee.

CONCESSIONS: Cash concession stand will be available in the gym area.

FACILITY:

TK Stone is an 8 lane, 25-yard indoor pool with non-turbulent dividers: Colorado Timing/Start System; 8 Line Digital Scoreboard. SR Smith starting blocks. The depth of the pool at the start end is 6 feet. The depth at the shallow end is 4 feet. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4)



It is important that swimmers and parents are aware of:

- 1. Clerk of course will be in the gym.
- 2. Team areas will be assigned in the TK Stone Gymnasium.
- 3. Swimmers must dry off prior to leaving the pool area.
- 4. There will be a one-way traffic flow around the pool deck for athletes and Spectators.
- 5. Food/Drink is not allowed in the pool area. Water is allowed in the pool area, but must be in sealed, spill-proof plastic containers. No glass containers are allowed in the building.
- 6. Signs or banners must be hung near team area by masking tape, string, or nondestructive hangers only. Banners should not be placed on canopies or on drywall.
- 7. Radios, noisemakers, or anything else that might cause inconvenience to swimmers, coaches, officials, workers, or spectators are prohibited.
- 8. Flash photography is prohibited during the start of heats.
- 9. Each team is responsible for the area assigned to them in TK Stone. All trash must be deposited in appropriate containers prior to each team departing the facility.
- 10. No horseplay will be tolerated.
- 11. Elizabethtown Independent Schools are a 100% Tobacco-Free System. Our schools prohibit ALL tobacco use by EVERYONE at ALL times on ALL school grounds and at ALL school-sponsored events.
- 12. Lost and found is located at Gate Check In. All items turned into lost and found will be held for 30 days. After that time all items will be disposed of or given to charity. The Elizabethtown Independent School District is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
