Events will run SLOWEST TO FASTEST and MIXED gender.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Swimmers must be current athlete members of USA Swimming as provided in Article 302 or as provided under 202.6 or USA Swimming "open border" policy.
- 2. Age is as of the first day of the meet, June 15, 2024.
- 3. Coaches must be current coach members of USA Swimming and must have credentials during the meet.
- 4. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

ENTRY LIMITS

Each swimmer may enter a maximum of ten individual events per day.

ENTRY NOTES

All events will be swum slowest to fastest with mixed genders. No Time (NT) entries will be accepted.

ENTRY FEES

\$8.00 per individual event (includes the KYLSC surcharge of \$0.35)

\$10.00 per relay

\$10* per individual deck entry (only swimmers already registered)

* Accepted at the discretion of the Meet Referee; payable at the meet.

WARM-UP NOTES

7:00am warm up time for all participants. Competition at 8:00am. Meet Director reserves the right to adjust warm up and competition times per facility limitations.

OFFICIAL'S MEETING

There will be an official's meeting 45 minutes prior to the start of swimming competition.

COACHES MEETING

A coaches' meeting will be held 15 minutes prior to the start of competition on Saturday morning. Additional coaches' meetings as necessary.

CONCESSIONS

Concessions may be sold near the pool area.

SWIMMERS WITH A DISABILITY

Entries for swimmers with a disability should be handled in the following manner: (1) enter the swimmer in the Hy-Tek database (or on the regular entry form); (2) Complete and submit with entries the Swimmers with a Disability Coach and Meet Referee Communication Form https://www.gomotionapp.com/team/szkyslsc/page/kylsc-meets and (3) provide any information about special accommodations needed by the swimmer. The final determination of seeding will be made by the Meet Referee after consultation with the swimmer and his/her coach.

OFFICIATING OPPORTUNITY

Anyone that is a USA Swimming certified official is welcome and encouraged to join the Kentucky Swimming officials in officiating this meet. Please contact the meet director in advance of the meet if possible, to apprise her of your availability at caty@raceaquatics.org.

All meet directors, referees, starters and stroke and turn judges, serving in an official capacity must be members of USA Swimming or other FINA-member organization. Except for coaches accompanying athletes participating under the provisions of 202.6 or USA Swimming's "open border" policy, all persons acting in any coaching capacity must be members of USA Swimming.

RULES

- · All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
- The use of audio or video recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms.
- · Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in the locker rooms or other designated areas "deck changing" is prohibited.
- · Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair. USA Swimming article 202.4.9 J

UNSUPERVISED SWIMMERS

USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. Swimmers participating under the provisions of 202.6 or USA Swimming's "open border" policy must be under the supervision of their coach or a USA Swimming member coach. Coaches who are entering swimmers but will not be at the meet should arrange ahead of time for another coach to supervise their athletes. Swimmers unaccompanied by their coaches or for whom arrangements have not been made must contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee who will assist the athlete in finding coach supervision.
