LOCATION Falling Spring Rec. Center; 275 Beasley Drive; Versailles, KY 40383
Take Exit 68 off of the Bluegrass Parkway • proceed 0.5 miles northbound on KY 33 to the stoplight intersection with KY 2113 (Falling Springs Blvd.) • turn left (westbound) onto KY 2113 • proceed 2.5 miles to the parking lot entrance on your left • pool is around to the right as you enter the facility.

FACILITY 8-lane, 25-yard indoor pool with Kiefer lane lines; fully automatic timing. The depth of the pool at the start end is 12 feet. The depth at the turn end is 4 feet. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE: Lifeguards will be on duty during the conduct of the meet. An AED is available at the facility.

DISCLAIMER: It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming and Kentucky Swimming, Inc. shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of this event.

FORMAT Timed finals age group meet open to USA Swimming registered athletes and teams: 10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14, and Open age divisions. Please utilize short course yard times when making entries.

SPECTATORS: Admission is free.

PARKING: The Falling Springs Center has a large parking lot available at no cost.

RULES No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Athlete Protection Policy: All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

Locker rooms will be available to swimmers only. Coaches, officials and meet workers will use the restrooms in the lobby.

The use of audio or video recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms.

Deck Changing is prohibited.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program & Events Committee Coordinator (or his/her designee).

Deck Access: Only athletes entered in the meet, coaches, officials, and meet workers will be allowed on deck.

ENTRY FEES: FEES \$6.00 per Individual Event entry
\$2.50 per swimmer Kentucky Swimming LSC surcharge +
\$12.50 per swimmer facility surcharge = \$15.00 total

ENTRY LIMITATIONS: Swimmers may enter up to five individual events

DECK ENTRIES: Deck entries will be permitted if open lanes are available. On-deck registration with USA Swimming will be permitted when proof of the athlete registration is shown to the meet referee.

ELIGIBILITY: Swimmers must be current athlete members of USA Swimming as provided in Article 302 or as provided under 202.6 or USA Swimming "open border" policy. Age is as of the first day of the meet.
Coaches must be current coach members of USA Swimming and must wear credentials during the meet.

SWIMMERS WITH A DISABILITY: Entries for swimmers with a disability should be handled in the following manner: (1) enter the swimmer in the Hy-Tek database; (2) complete the SWIMMERS WITH A DISABILITY COACH AND MEET REFEREE COMMUNICATION form and email accompanying the Hy-Tek entry file.
Items to included: name of the swimmer, the stroke(s)/distance(s) s/he wishes to swim, the entry times, the day/session s/he wishes to swim the event(s), and the manner in which s/he prefers to be seeded (with a longer distance or with a different age group); and (3) provide any information about special accommodations needed by the swimmer. The final determination of seeding will be made by the Meet Referee after consultation with the swimmer and his/her coach.

CONDUCT: The meet will be conducted according to the rules set forth in the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations. Events will be contested in a short course yards pool. All events will be pre-seeded; no events will be deck seeded. Heats will be swum slowest to fastest.

AWARDS: 1st through 8th place ribbons will be awarded in each event.

SAFETY/WARM-UP: Coaches must maintain contact with their swimmers during warm-up. All entry into the pool for warm-up is feet first from the end of the pool. There is no diving during warm-ups, except in designated sprint lanes.

OFFICIALS: All meet directors, referees, starters and stroke and turn judges serving in an official capacity must be members of USA Swimming or other FINA-member organization. Except for coaches accompanying athletes participating under the provisions of 202.6 or USA Swimming's "open border" policy, all persons acting in any coaching capacity must be members of USA Swimming.

HOSPITALITY: Will be provided to coaches and meet officials.

WARM-UPS: To start at 8:00 A.M. A complete schedule of lane assignments and times for all warm-up procedures which must be adhere to by all participants will be emailed by Noon on Friday, Oct. 27, 2023 and posted at the pool.
