- New members were selected for the committee. A coach liaison was added to help provide a coach's perspective to the business of the committee and provide LSC coaches an avenue to express any concerns or questions. This has been very successful so far.
- Officials' committee members continue to update SC-LSC officials pages on website.
- Officials' committee members elected to implement a 60 day grace period Official's apprentice option rather than require new apprenticing officials commit to non-athlete membership fees, background check fees and take the APT course before working any deck sessions. USA Swimming required all LSC's to implement either program.
- Officials' committee members created new apprentice forms for S&T, CJ, SR, DR and MR. Instructions have been provided to members. The new apprentice forms can be found on the website.
- Monthly Officials newsletter continues to be published.
- There were 23 officials evaluated for 27 national certifications during the LC state meet. Many thanks to the Soderstrom's for being the meet's evaluators. They had many positive comments regarding the training level of the SC-LSC's officials.

- Mark Posey reported he has several other LSC's requesting copies of our training materials and apprentice forms so they can use them for their LSC. This is a very positive measure of our LSC's growth in the training and apprenticing area compared to prior years.
- Mailed all officials name tags and awards that were not picked up during the LC State meet or the All State Banquet.
- Reminders have been sent out to members to start reviewing the recertification requirements for those with certifications expiring on 12/31/14.
- Great responses have been received regarding the new officials' recognition of services program. Folks are appreciating the thank you's and public recognitions.
- The officials committee reviewed the results of the championship sub-committee recommendations. Committee members agree with the recommendations of the group.
- The officials committee discussed their recommendations regarding changing time standards for SC state meet. Committee members appreciated being included in the discussion. Input from all members indicated the majority were opposed to dividing the 15-18 age group into two classes and majority suggested the time changes not be as drastic as what the numbers indicate they should be changed to for the male 15-18 group as a whole.
