Roll Call:

The meeting was called to order by Aimee Onoszko at 4:30 pm and began with the reading of the SCS Vision, Mission, Core Values and Duty to Serve.



Unfinished Business (from Meeting 1):

<u>Legislation – R2</u> – C heat – strike; "B" heat, then "A" heats in finals, for all events (except 500 Free, 400 IM), regardless of how many swimmers participate in each event; board approved unanimously for recommendation

<u>Time standards</u> - Para swimming – add a line in the meet information (athlete eligibility) – suggested time standards from USA Swimming (see below) – board approved unanimously for recommendation

Language added to the SC State time standards document - PARA-SWIMMING: Para-Swimming athletes are eligible to compete at LSC Championships provided they achieve the USA Swimming suggested LSC time standards for any offered event

<u>Howard Wheeler Award</u> – Swimmer of Year – use FINA power points – had 2 para swimmers achieve high standards (Parker Egbert, Maria Francescotti) – Para-athletes and criteria will be incorporated into the selection process – 2 Male, 2 Female awards will be given this year (legislation attached) – board approved unanimously for recommendation

<u>LEAP</u> – Renewal of this certification (USA Swimming) – Chip Holland – provided update (Governance, Communication and Programming) – LSC Survey on website and will go out on May 1st; Working with summer league programs, developing mentoring and coaching programs – offering resources to help summer league programs – want to roll out coach development by fall; have created a Parents 101 page, Coaches and Athletes page on the website

<u>Sports Development Director Report</u> – Registrations near 3200.....ahead of pre-COVID numbers; new coaches, new clubs; media and communications interactions have gone up 18%; Facebook up 22.5%; working on Zone team and camps; SC Swimming has offered sponsorship money to summer league championship meets and flyers to hand out at meet; there will be another developmental swim camp (weekend of June 18th) – invitations will be sent out next week (11-14 age group) – 48 athletes; may possibly do another camp in August or September

<u>Carolina Crown Update</u> – Great success; had a full house – even split between coaches, athletes from NC and SC; selection process changed this year – top 25 athletes in each event were invited first; then 2nd round; next year meet will be in Greensboro, NC

New Business - Committee activity (afternoon sessions)

<u>DEI Committee</u> – Carolina Diversity camp – successful event – had more athletes from NC than SC – want more representation from SC next year; Next year – will host 12 and under swim clinic; June 4th –



hosting a free swim clinic – Fire Department, Sheriff Department and other organizations will be on site – Richland County pool (Eastover); looking to educate community and boost high school swimming in the area; DEI Committee ideally wants one athlete from each club to represent and serve

USAS DEI meeting – discussed transgender athletes; Community impact grants – encourage USA clubs to create swim lesson programs

<u>Senior Committee</u> – Discussed Howard Wheeler award; the Mile event at state meets – distance session or AM/PM option; possible to have Mile on a different day of the meet – will discuss further; Families are seeing an increase in cost with travel in general, and more so for flights – may need to look at establishing reimbursement guidelines for national level meets

Open water zones – established the foundation of selection process; state meet will be used to get to determine camp selection; use the open water camp and race as selection process for Zones team; Zones roster would ideally be done in late September and will be an LSC sponsored travel trip – 4 athletes per age group, per gender – can have 4 more athletes – wildcard – 24 total athletes (3 to 4 coaches, 1 to 2 chaperones)

Finale Meet – want to re-introduce this into the state meet between prelims and finals – limit to events offered; allows SC swimming to serve more swimmers – long course only – this would need to be introduced and legislated in October – can bid on for 2023-2024 calendar

Select camps – travel costs are sharply increasing – athletes must provide transportation (USA Swimming pays for food and lodging); **Have reimbursed 44 athletes for expenses, prior to summer championship meets (families have spent over \$42 K; we have reimbursed \$20,600 to athletes (about 57% reimbursement rate); budget number keeps going up for this reason

<u>Athlete Committee</u> – Elections –used a google form; had lots of athlete participation; <u>Nominations</u> – New Athlete Reps – Caden Wolf – Athlete at Large; Darden Tate – new Senior rep; Alex Ritz – Junior rep; Jake Root – Athlete at Large; Lilly Gault Abdella – Athlete at Large; added 3 athletes at large – per PNP – at least 20% of board members are athletes

 $\underline{\text{Medals}} - 3$ different options (to include new logo); will cost more (in the budget) – recommend option 3 with a solid strap for each place medal – 3 inch medals (approx. \$2.91 each) – LSC will pay for medals – 5 state meets; board recommended for approval



<u>Appointments</u> – Roy Deschloch will retire from Governance – Robert Lesh is nominated for committee – Para Swimming committee – Annette Francescotti is nominated for chair; Change name of committee from Disability to Para Swimming Committee; board unanimously approved all motions for recommendation

<u>Board retreat</u> – June 4th and 5th – Open water meet; Madren Center – board meetings; be sure committees are meeting – will cover Governance and strategic plan at June meeting

If more than six athletes meet these considerations, the spots will be filled by applicants with the highest USA Swimming/Hy-Tek long course power point score overall in a single event, similar to the second-round selection process.

Proposed new language: 2. Howard Wheeler Memorial Award

a. The Howard Wheeler Award is presented annually to the highest ranked 18 & under male and female swimmers and para-swimmers in an Olympic event, in addition to the Men's 800/1000 freestyle events and Women's 1500/1650 freestyle events. Relay lead-offs will be used for selection. Time Trials will not be considered. The SWIMS database will be utilized to choose the highest ranking results or equivalent for the winners. In case of a time, the swimmer's next highest-ranking results will be considered until the tie is broken. The qualifying period will begin April 15th of the current year and conclude April 14th of the year the award is given. All USA-Swimming sanctioned or approved long-course meter and short-course yard competitions will be considered for the award. All NCAA and NJCAA and NAIA sanctioned meets will be excluded from the selection process. The Howard Wheeler Award will be presented annually at the South Carolina Swimming Banquet.
