- R1- Scott McMillian language clean up in PNP for "non-conforming time"; would change this to "non-proven time" **unanimously passed**
- R2 Awarding and Recognizing All State Swimmers let the athletes decide how/what the LSC should do to celebrate athletes (want to remove the word "banquet" from the P and P) changes will be made in conjunction with Senior, Athlete and Age Group committees allows for flexibility from year to year the board recommended this legislation Amendment proposed consideration for awards date cutoff April 10th amendment accepted legislation passed by 96% vote
