

2013 -14 Short Course Meet Bids

By April 1: Bids from Group Members to host the next year's Southeastern Championship and District Meets are due to the SES Executive Secretary and posted on the SES website. These bids shall include proposed dates, all associated fees, and contact person Clubs are informed that they have 10 days (April 10) to vote for any of the aforementioned meets which have more than one bidder.

April 10: Votes are counted and clubs are approved to host the Southeastern Championship and District Meets.

April 11: Final bids for club-hosted meets for the current year's SC season (September 1 – March 31) are due.

The General Chairman determines if any conflicts are present. If they are, then:

Step 1: General Chairman asks the teams in conflict to either resolve it in a mutually acceptable manner or to agree that neither team views the scheduling of the meets in question as a conflict.

April 30: Final SES SC Meet schedule beginning on September 1 of the current year is published on the SES website.

Meet Bids will be accepted until 6:00 PM CST, April 11, 2013.

All meet bid/sanction forms must be received by the SE office April 29, 2013—form and money.
