Age Group Chairman Report - October 4-5, 2008

I. 2008 LCM Season Age Group Overview

- A) We had 146 <u>more</u> IMX long course scores out of 14&Under swimmers than we did in 2007. In addition, we had twenty-one 14&Under swimmers ranked in the Top 50 nationally for the 2008 LCM season (up from 14 in 2007). This is partly due to more long course meet opportunities that swimmers had available due to a longer season and hopefully due to better coaching!
- B) The loosening of the 12&Under time standards combined with more long course meet opportunities certainly had an effect on the number of 12&Under swimmers at the Long Course Championships. In 2008, there were 115 more 12&Under swimmers at the meet than 2007.
- C) While there are some tweaks and changes that can potentially be made to positively impact the Zone selection format, the bottom line is that we simply were not as strong from a 14&Under standpoint as we have been in years past. Before any changes are to be made, we should form a committee to fully vet any adjustments and we should wait to see if there is a change in the Zone Meet itself coming out of Convention (which is entirely possible given the new landscape of meets on the National calendar).

II. <u>Items of Interest for Age Group Coaches</u>

- A) There will be a proposal at Convention to restrict some "tech" swimsuits from Age Group competition. However, this legislation will most likely deal with the length of the suit rather than material. Regardless of the outcome of this legislation, it is a good thing for all age group coaches to discuss the matter of high performance swimming suits with their team. Policies or guidelines within each team based on that team's philosophy should help age group coaches in dealing with this situation before it becomes a major problem.
- B) The IMX is a very valuable tool to motivate and chart swimmers' progress and improvement in all of the strokes and longer distances. Rankings (Club, LSC, Zone, National) can be obtained through this report and through any coach's My USA Swimming Page. Swimmers will be able to access their scores through their own My USA Swimming page as well as print their own IMX certificate any time they wish. Visit the USA Swimming website to establish your FREE My USA Swimming webpage. In addition, be creative and develop your own uses for IMX as they best fit your training group. Remember that the goal should be to encourage well rounded swimmers and improvement in all of the disciplines as these young athletes develop mentally and physically. The IMX and similar programs are simply tools to meet that end.
- C) USA Swimming is in the process of developing a companion tool to the IMXtreme program under the working title "IM Ready." This program will be purely achievement based (i.e. no rankings) and will be a feeder program into the IMX. The program will utilize shorter distances, but still focus on all of the strokes and Individual Medley. More information on this program will be available soon, but I encourage all coaches who are interested to develop their own similar program as a tool to improve development in swimming.

III. Age Group Information & Education

- A) The 2008 ASCA World Clinic was held September 3-7 in Las Vegas, Nevada. I would strongly encourage clubs to send Age Group Coaches to this clinic despite the distance. Very few clubs have been sending age group coaches in previous years.
- B) Upcoming Clinics Eastern States Clinic October 16-19 Cherry Hill, NJ (ASCA courses will be offered on October 18-19) will feature swimmers Ryan Lochte and Kaitlin Sandeno as well as coaches Richard Quick, David Marsh, and Gregg Troy.
- C) The ASCA Website (<u>www.swimmingcoach.org</u>) is a great resource for articles, audio, and other coaching materials.

IV. Southern Zone All Star Meet

A) 2008 Southern Zone Meet - Meet was held July 29-August 2 at Georgia Tech. Coaching Staff - Matt Webber (BSL) was Head Coach. Jackie Bertucci

- (PACK), Bryan Welter (NAC), Mark Krimm (XCEL), and Jenell Eckert (HBT) were assistant coaches. A report from the 2008 SES Zone Meet is listed below.
