

Southeastern Swimming LCM Time Standards Report & Proposed 2023 Qualifying Times submitted by Brian Haddad

The following report details the proposed changes to the 2023 Southeastern Swimming Long Course Qualifying Times for consideration at the Coaches Committee Meeting August 27, 2022. Please read carefully. This page will have bullet points regarding proposed changes.

- For 2023, twelve Qualifying Times are proposed for change
- 10&U and 11-12 Qualifying Times for both Girls and Boys Calculated in the Following Manner:
 - For 50 meter events and 100 meter events, time standard changed to 64th place finish at 2022 Southeastern Championships. Time standard not changed if not 64 results.
 - For 200 meter events, time standard changed to 56th place finish at 2022 Southeastern Championships. Time standard not changed if not 56 results.
 - For 400 meter events, time standard changed to 40th place finish at 2022 Southeastern Championships. Time standard not changed if not 40 results
- 13-14 Qualifying Times for both Girls and Boys Calculated in the Following Manner:
 - 3 year average of 32nd place in all events **except** the events listed below.
 - 3 year average of 24th place in the 400 Free, 800 Free, 1500 Free, and 400 IM.
- Senior Qualifying Times for both Girls and Boys Calculated in the Following Manner:
 - 3 year average of 56th place – 50 Free
 - 3 year average of 48th place – 100 Free, 100 Back, 100 Breast, 100 Fly
 - 3 year average of 40th place – 200 Free, 200 Back, 200 Breast, 200 Fly, 200 IM
 - 3 year average of 24th place – 400 Free, 400 IM
 - 3 year average of 16th place – 800 Free, 1500 Free
- I have included projected Bonus cuts for events factored at 2% over proposed standards
- As per legislation passed in 2015, all events 400 and longer will not have a Bonus Standard available.
