

## Diving

**Minimum Age Limit:** 25 years

**Age Determining Date:** The actual age of the competitor as of December, 31 (2018).

**Age Groups:** Springboard and platform events: 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80+ and five-year age groups as long as necessary.

**Practice Provision:** Practice opportunities will be available 20-21 July 2018 from 08:00 to 18:00 hours at the Aquatic Center. Practice opportunities will also be available on competition days. Details of practice times will be given to competitors at registration. All practices times will be open.

**Technical Meeting:** A technical meeting will be held on Saturday 21 July 2018 at 10:00am. The meeting location and details will be available on the official web page event [www.2018PanAmMasters.com](http://www.2018PanAmMasters.com). This meeting is for athletes, coaches and managers.

**Entry Restrictions:** A diver may enter a maximum of seven events: the 1-M springboard, 3-M springboard, the platform, the synchronized 3-M springboard, synchronized platform, mixed synchro 3-M and Mixed Synchro Platform event.

Divers are allowed to compete in only one club team in the 3-M synchronized diving event and only one club team in the platform synchronized diving event.

### MD 1.3.3 The Age Group in Synchronized Diving is decided by adding the ages of the two divers.

**MD 1.3.4** If in any of the two groups in Synchronized Diving the age of a diver is 50 years or more, the limitation from 10M platform dives of only feet first and any dive from 10M must not exceed degree of difficulty 2.0 applies for the pair.

## Open Water

**Race Distance:** 3K, 1K

**Minimum Age Limit:** 20 years

**Age Determining Date:** The actual age of the competitor as of 31 December 2018.

**Age Groups:** 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90-94 and five year increments as high as necessary.

Swimmers will be seeded by age/gender. Athletes will be started in waves based on age group and or gender. Race organizers, in consultation with the referee and subject to advice from the UANA Masters Technical Committee, have designated a cut-off time for each Masters race of 90 minutes. All swimmers will be required to wear highly visible colored numbered swim caps, which will be provided.

**Use of Wetsuits:** Wet suits are NOT permitted.

**Training Provision:** Training opportunities may be available in the warm up/warm down pools, daily at Aquatic Center. Training may also be done on the competition course the day before the event.

**Technical Meeting:** The Open Water technical meeting will be held on Friday August 3, 2018 at 16:00 hours. Location to be announced on the host official website. [www.2018panamasters.com](http://www.2018panamasters.com)

**Competition Date:** August 4, 2018. The tentative start time for Open Water event is 07:00am.

**Length of Course:** 3 kilometers. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reduce the length of the swim, based on medical advice should adverse weather conditions prevail.

**Competition Venue:** The open water course is TBD and will be announced on the official website.

**Water Temperature:** 85-88 Degrees F



## Open Water

**Transport:** The YMCA Aquatic Center will have transportation from the Aquatic Center to the competition site. A complete transportation schedule will be announced on the host website [www.2018panammasters.com](http://www.2018panammasters.com).

**Time Limits:** Swimmers who cannot complete the 3K distance in 90 minutes (1.5 hours) are advised to not enter. Swimmers still on the course will be clearly visible after this time may be stopped at their progress marked.

**Marshaling Area:** All athletes must be in the marshaling area  $\frac{1}{2}$  hour before their allowed wave. A map showing the course will be clearly visible in this area for all the participants.

**Safety:** Full medical provision and appropriate safety craft will be provided during and at the end of competition.

**Changing Area:** Competitors must leave their equipment in this area. The Organizing Committee will provide a bright colored cap for each swimmer. Each swimmer is required to wear this cap. Thermal caps may NOT be worn.

**Support Facilities:** Shower and changing facilities will be available.

**Hospitality:** Hot drinks and fruits will be provided in the catering area.

**Medals:** Medals will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> place in each age group.

**Minimum Age Limit:** 18 Years

**Age Groups, Individual Events:** 18-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90-94 and five-year age increments as high as necessary.

**Note:** 18-24 age groups are not permitted to participate on relay teams: 100-119, 120-159, 160-199, 200-239, 240-279, 280-319, 320-359

**Technical Meeting:** The swimming technical meeting will be held on Friday July 27<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 1600 hours. The location will be announced on the host official website ([www.2018PamAmMasters.com](http://www.2018PamAmMasters.com)). This meeting is for athletes, coaches and managers.

**Competition Dates:** July 28 – August 3, 2018

**Technical Meeting:** The swimming technical meeting will be held on Friday July 27<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 1600 hours. The location will be announced on the host official website ([www.2018PamAmMasters.com](http://www.2018PamAmMasters.com)). This meeting is for athletes, coaches and managers.

**Minimum Age Limit:** 18 Years Old

**Individual Events:** 18-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90-94 and five-year age increments as high as necessary.

**Relay events:** 18-24 age groups are not permitted to participate on relay teams: 100-119, 120-159, 160-199, 200-239, 240-279, 280-319, 320-359

**Training Provision:** The YMCA Aquatic Center will be open for training from 0600 to 2200 hours (6:00am to 10:00pm). The venue may be limited for warm up to those athletes only competing on that day. Please see refer to the hosts official website ([www.2018.PanAmMasters.com](http://www.2018.PanAmMasters.com)) for most up to date warm up schedules and pool availability.



## Swimming

We may limit the total number of athletes to register for the sport of swimming in an effort to not exceed 10 hours of competition a day. We are committed to giving the athletes and their families the opportunity to enjoy all that Orlando has to offer. We may also limit the number of heats for the 400 Free, 800 Free, and the 400 IM in order to provide the best experience for our athletes and their families.

**Competition Venue:** Indoor Diving Well Pool 25 meter x 25 yards

**Age Groups:**

**Solo and Duet Events:** 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, 70-79, 80+

**Teams:** 20-34, 35-49, 50-64, 65+

**Free Combination:** 20-39, 40-64, 65+

For duet and free combination and team events the category is determined by the average age of the competitors as per MSS Rule 1.5.

**Technical Meeting:** The synchronized swimming technical meeting will be held on Tuesday July, 24 2018 at 10:00am. The location of this meeting will be informed at [www.2018PanAmMasters.com](http://www.2018PanAmMasters.com). This meeting is for athletes, coaches and managers and covers the following:

- Correction to spelling off athlete's names
- Procedure for draws
- Order of appearance draw
- Reserve procedure in duet and team events
- Pre-Competition warm up
- Call room procedures
- Marshaling and walk
- Warm down facilities
- Victory ceremonies

**Practice Provision:** Practice opportunities with music will be available in the competition pool. Additional practice opportunities will be made available during the competition period. The exact times of practice are subject to entry numbers. Details will be provided on arrival from the competitor registration point



## Synchronized Swimming

**Sound Equipment:** Competitors are responsible for providing their own music, based on the music guidelines from the 2017-2021 FINA rulebook and will also be posted on the official website.

**Entry Restrictions:** Athletes may enter no more than three (3) routine events and one (1) free combination. All Duets and team and free combination competitors must represent the same club. Each club may submit up to a maximum of five (5) routine entries per age group per event. Each Club may enter one free combination in each age group.

**Competition:** Each team shall consist of a minimum of four (4) and maximum of eight (8) members. Each Free Routine Combination shall consist of a minimum of (4) and a maximum of (10) members.

**Time Limits:** Please see the FINA Handbook MSS 4,1 for time requirements for each category of Routine. There is no minimum time limit. There shall be an allowance of fifteen (15) seconds plus the allotted time for Technical Routines, Free Routines and Free Combination.

**Technical Routines:** The technical routine shall be performed for solos, duets and teams, to music as described in Appendix 1 of FINA MSS rules, with the required elements selected by the Masters Technical Committee every four years, subject to approval by the FINA Bureau. Technical routines must include all required elements. Music selection is optional and may be the same as the music used in the free routine.

Goggles may be worn.

Please see the 2017 – 2021 FINA Handbook Masters Synchronized Swimming Section for a full description of all Elements which will be performed in each Technical Routine.

**Reporting:** It is the responsibility of each competitor, including all members of duets and teams, to report to at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the designated event.

**Medals:** Medals will be awarded in all events 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each group (each member of a duet/team will receive a medal including alternates).

## Water Polo

**Minimum Age Limit:** 30 Years

**Age Determining Date:** The actual age of the competitor as of 31 December 2018. Ages will need to be verified by Passport or official federation identification with photo included.

**Team Gender:** The 2018 Pan American Masters Championships are open to master's club registered with the member Federations of UANA. The teams entered may be Men's Club Teams and Women's Club teams. Women may be members of the men's teams.

**Team Age Group:** The age of the youngest member of the team determines the age group of the team. There are no restrictions on the ages of the players older than the youngest player on the team. Age groups for teams, both men and women, are five-year intervals beginning with 30. i.e. 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, and five year increments as high as necessary. If there are fewer than three teams entered in an age group they will be offered the opportunity to compete in the next youngest age group.

**Training Opportunities:** Training opportunities will be available at the YMCA Aquatic Center on Saturday 4 August 2018. Requests for training may be made by written request prior to arrival, or on arrival at the competitor registration desk for water polo. Further training opportunities will be announced at the technical meeting.

**Warm Up:** Athletes must enter the water using extreme caution. All athletes who do not comply with the safety rules set out by the organization or once guilty of unsportsmanlike conduct, may be sanctioned by the tournament committee and/or the UANA Masters Technical committee.



## Water Polo

**Equipment:** Teams will be responsible for providing their own practice and warm up water polo balls. The Organizing Committee will provide the competition match balls, which will be the officials FINA water polo balls. Game caps must be brought by the team, but teams may use their own caps, provided the numbers on caps conform to FINA rule WP4.

**Note:** MWP 5.1 provides for a list of 15 players in masters water polo

**Composition of Team:** FINA Masters Water Polo latest rules apply to this competition. Please ensure that the composition of a team complies with MWP 4 and the number of players complies with MWP5.

**Periods of Matches:**

**FINA WP11 Rules apply with the following exceptions:**

As for category 30+, 35+, 40+, 45+ each of the four periods shall have the duration of seven minutes of actual play; the time of ball possession shall be 35 seconds.

As for the category 50+, 55+, 60+ and the following ones , each of the four periods shall have the duration of 6 minutes of actual play; the time of ball possession shall be 35 seconds.

**For example**, a team may list up to 15 players on their team entry form to participate in any game of this tournament, i.e. seven players and 8 reserves. A player may only represent one club in the competition and all players must be registered with the same club. However, a player may represent that club on two teams but in this case each of them must have nine players that are only on the roster for that team.



## Water Polo

**Competition Format:** The competition format will depend on the number of teams entered in each age group. If there are fewer than three teams entered in a age group, the teams will be contacted to determine if they are willing to play in the next youngest age group. If there are not enough teams in an age group, that age group will be combined with the next most appropriate age group as determined by the tournament director and play through that age group keeping separate rankings. Brackets and placements will be at the discretion of the tournament director. Each age group will have separate final placement and awards.

**Reporting:** It is the responsibility of each team to be ready to play at least 15 minutes prior to the designated starting time for their match. Teams arriving later than 5 minutes after the designate start time for their match will forfeit the match, with the match awarded to the opponent with the goal score of 5-0.

**Medals:** A maximum of 15 medals (dependent upon the size of the team entered) will be awarded to teams placing 1<sup>st</sup>– 3<sup>rd</sup> in each division. Each player on the team will receive a medal.

### ENTRY PROCEDURES FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS

**Participants must present and submit the following documentation:** proof of age, registration cards and photo used for accreditation.

**Entry Deadline:** The final date for entries to be received by the Organization Committee is June 30, 2018 at Midnight.

**FINA Affiliation:** All Masters Competitors must be registered with a FINA Member Federation and demonstrate it with a Masters License, Club Registration Card or Federation Membership Card.

**Entry Checklist:** For an entry to be accepted by the Organizing Committee the following forms will need to be provided for validation: photo copy of ID card or passports, Guarantee issued by the National Swimming Federation and fees must be submitted on the registration site.

## Essential Entry Info

**Individual Registration Form:** Every competitor entering the Championships must complete the relevant sections on the online entry form and sign the waiver of liability.

**Team Entry Form:** For teams entering water polo, swimming relays, synchronized swimming and Synchronized diving the appropriate team entry form must be completed by a team representative.

**Passport Sized Photographs:** One photograph with the competitor's name must be attached to the individual online registration form for the Championship identification card.

**Proof of Age:** A photocopy of an official document, i.e. passport, driver's license or birth certificate showing the competitor's date of birth must be attached (PDF format).

**Registration Card/Travel Permit:** A photocopy of the competitor's club Registration Card or Masters License issued by their respective national swimming organization must be attached (PDF format).

**Payment:** Payment of fees in full, including the Individual Registration fee and the appropriate sport entry fees must be enclosed or authorized and made by credit card charge.

**Championship Entries:** Faxed entries will not be accepted. All Championship entries must be online.

## Eligibility

Any athlete that is a citizen of the Pan American continents may participate in the Pan American Championship. Athletes from other continents may participate as guests.

Athletes from overseas will be presented with medals, without interfering with the awarding of athletes with citizenship in the Americas. All competitors must represent a club, association, fitness academies, will NOT permit athlete entry who representing a country team.


