COMMENTS

COMMENTS

United States continued their dominance at both ends of the pool, beating Argentina 21-4. With the win USA qualifies for the 2019 World Championships and earns a chance to play for the gold medal. USA controlled both ends of the field of play and was able to outscore their opponent 8-1. The Americans continued their controlled offensive and defensive game tempo, increasing their lead to 12-2 at halftime. Both teams started the third quarter with many miscues and missed opportunities. USA regains their composure and starts scoring at will during the last four minutes of the quarter, while at the same time increasing their defensive intensity. Argentina comes out and scores the first two goals of the last quarter, but the Americans counter with four of their own, increasing to their lead. Bowen (#9) led the USA with five goals. His team plays Brazil for the gold medal. Argentina play Canada for the bronze medal. They had four players score one goal apiece.



1st quarter was total control by USA offensively and defensively out scoring Argentina 8 - 1. 2nd quarter very similar to the 1st with USA in total control of the game. Out scoring their opponent 4 - 1 in this quarter. Score at halftime is USA 12 - 2 over Argentina. 3rd quarter both teams come out and play sloppy. USA continues to score goals at will out scoring Argentina 5 - 1. Final quarter Argentina makes a push and scores 2 quick goals but USA then starts to take over play and out scores Argentina 4 - 2 with the final score USA 21 - Argentina 4.
