PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

All photographs must meet generally accepted standards of decency in particular:

- Action shots should be a celebration of the sporting activity and not a sexualized image in a sporting context.
- Action shots should not be taken or retained where the photograph reveals a torn or displaced swimsuit.
- Photographs should not be taken from behind swimming blocks at the start of a race or exhibit a child climbing out of the swimming pool.
- Photographs should not be taken in locker rooms or bathrooms. Cottonwood Heights Aquatics Team will take photographs (individual and in groups) of swimmers under the age of 18 that may include your child during their time on the team.

All photos will be taken and published in line with the team policy. The team requires parental consent to take and use photographs. Parents have a right to refuse agreement to their child being photographed and may choose to opt out of having their swimmer's photo published on any of the team platforms.
